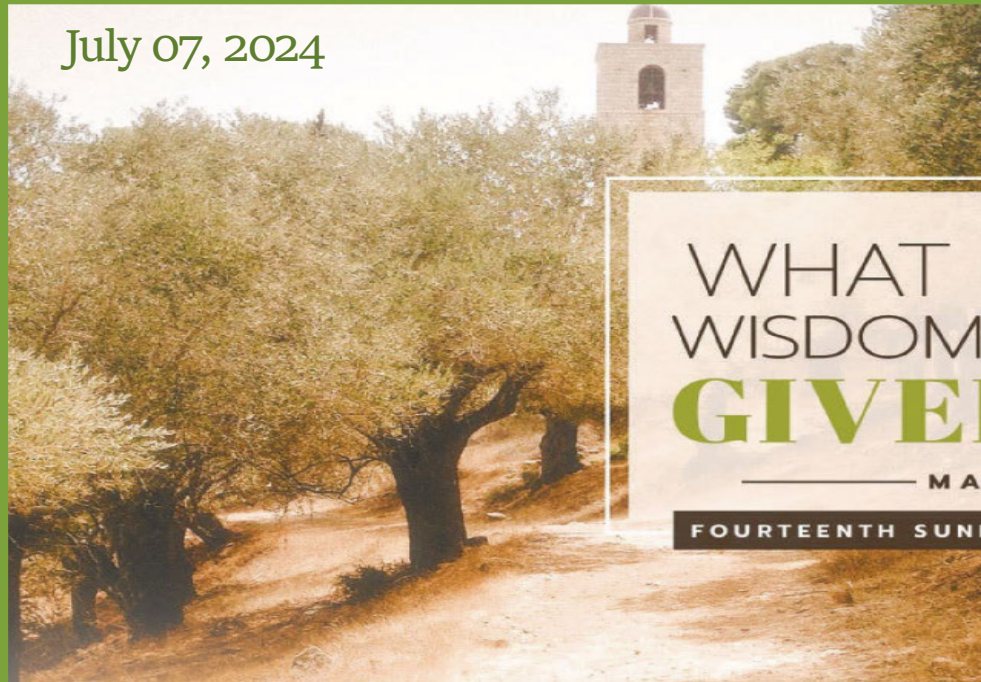

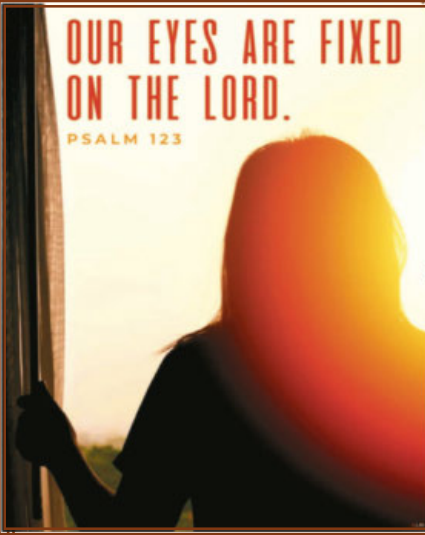

*Sunday's Readings: Ezekiel 2:2-5; Ps 123:1-2, 2, 3-4 (2cd);
2 Corinthians 12:7-10; Mark 6:1-6a*

Gospel Reflection : *Recently I watched a bunch of YouTube videos on how to optimize willpower in the face of weakness. The message was: do not accept your weakness. Crush it. Dominate it. In one video, however, at the end of a rant by a willpower coach, the muscular stoic admitted, "You'll never actually get what you want, no matter how hard you try." Amazingly, he admitted that willpower alone is not sufficient for us weak-willed humans.*

What does God want us to do with our weaknesses, if crushing them with willpower won't work? For example, what should I do with my tendency to arrogance and self-isolation? Or my procrastination? Or my intellectual and physical limitations? Or my selfishness?

The counter-intuitive answer is clear in this week's words from St Paul, "I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses in order that the power of Christ may dwell in me (2 Cor. 12:9)." Boast of our weaknesses? Paul isn't promoting weak-mindedness or laziness. Rather, he perceives that Jesus loves us not despite our weaknesses but because of them. Boasting of our weakness means claiming human will is not all we have. It means turning to God whenever we feel weak, which—let's face it—is almost all the time. When we do, we learn to love our weaknesses, because it's there that we meet the strength of Christ. This week, I challenge us to find ways to boast not in willpower but in weakness.

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XIV-MÙA THUỜNG NIÊN Mc 6:1-6

KHÔNG TIN, KHÔNG CÓ PHÉP LẠ

Suy niệm: Xuyên suốt Tin Mừng, phép lạ chỉ xảy ra đối với những kẻ có lòng tin. Có lần Chúa Giê-su lên tiếng khen ngợi chính lòng tin đã cứu chữa người bệnh. Có người bị Chúa trách "kém tin", nhưng với chút lòng tin còn yếu kém đó, họ cũng được Chúa ban phép lạ và lòng tin của họ được củng cố mạnh mẽ hơn. Nhờ niềm tin vào quyền năng và tình thương của Thiên Chúa, mà họ đã được chữa lành trở nên con người mới. Hơn nữa, Chúa Giê-su còn thúc giục họ gia tăng lòng tin vào Con Thiên Chúa để cũng làm được những phép lạ như Ngài (x. Mt 17,20). Nhưng tiếc thay hôm nay, nơi quê quán Ngài, Chúa không thể làm phép lạ, vì họ không có lòng tin.

Mời Ban: Với nhiều người, nhất là người trẻ thời nay, niềm tin tôn giáo là không đáng tin vì thiếu những bằng chứng thực nghiệm. Thế nhưng bên cạnh những phát biểu đầy tự phụ ấy, trong thời đại dịch này, người ta cũng dễ dàng nhận ra rằng, con người thật là yếu ớt, và khả năng của con người cũng đung phải những giới hạn. Chúa nói với dân thành Na-da-rét, Ngài không làm phép lạ vì họ không tin. Chúa không hứa sẽ làm cho bệnh dịch biến đi trong một cái nháy mắt, nhưng nếu chúng ta có lòng tin, chúng ta sẽ thấy những điều kỳ diệu hơn thế nữa (x. Ga 1,50).

Sống Lời Chúa: Thánh Phao-lô dạy đức tin có là nhờ nghe lời rao giảng, mà lời rao giảng của các tông đồ được ghi lại trong Kinh Thánh (Rm 10,17). Vậy mời bạn siêng năng suy niệm Lời Chúa để tăng thêm niềm tin.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Chúa, xin ban thêm niềm tin còn yếu đuối của chúng con.*

The Salesian Sisters - India

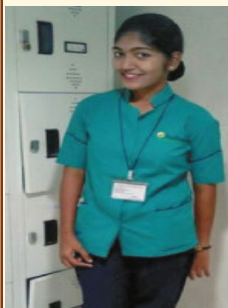
Next weekend July 13th & 14th, Mr. Thomas LeClair, a Lay Person who knows and works well in collaboration with the Salesian Sisters of Mumbai, will be preaching at all Masses to tell us about the missionary works of the **Salesian Sisters in Mumbai, India**. Together with lay collaborators, the salesian sisters are dedicated to the education and evangelization of young people and their families through schools, camps, retreats, catechesis, youth and young adult parish ministries, oratories, and after-school programs. They share Christ's mission in the Church especially through Christian education in the style of the Preventive system – a system of loving kindness, drawn from the heart of Christ Himself.

This visit is part of the national program, in which annually a representative of one of the missionary groups visits parishes of the Diocese, to invite the Parish to share in the works of the Universal Church. Each of us as baptized Catholics are called to share in the work of evangelization. Please donate generously! Below is a write up about the Sisters and their work.....

Empowering Young Girls: From Poverty to a New Life in India

In this year's mission appeal on the weekend of July 13,14, we will learn how we can **dramatically change the lives of poor girls in India**. In Gandhinagar, Gujarat, India – a poverty-stricken area – Salesian sisters want to build a hostel that will house poor girls as they train for new careers and a real life. **Without this hostel, girls will be married at 13 or 14 and have more children than they can care for. Or, a girl could be traded for a pig, just to support a family. Or she could be captured by ruthless sex traffickers and condemned to a horrible life.** With the hostel, she will have the chance for a real life, a real career. It is that simple and that dramatic.

Here are two village girls; both were born to grinding poverty in a poor Indian village.



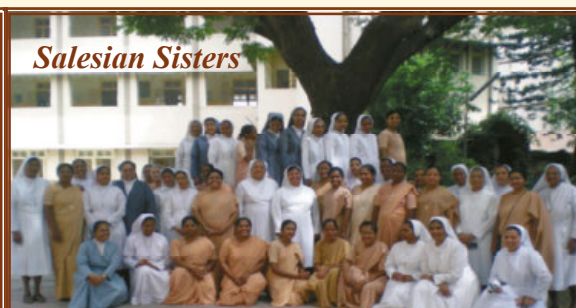
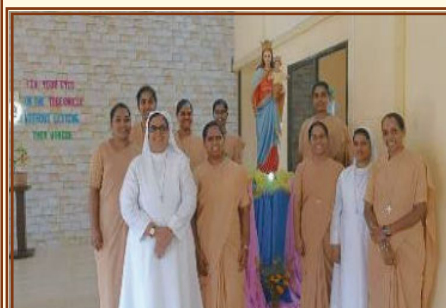
One girl will never leave her village. ➡ She will drop out of school, be forced to marry young, and will work for \$3 a day at back-breaking labor for the rest of her life.

↩ **Hemlata, the other girl, trained by the sisters, is now on staff at a hospital.** With your help, many more Hemlatas will have dignity, a good job and a real future. If we can help build, the Salesians sisters in Gandhinagar will educate hundreds of girls just like her. These girls will break the cycle of poverty that has plagued their families for generations.

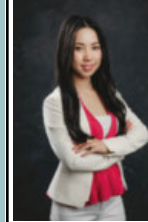

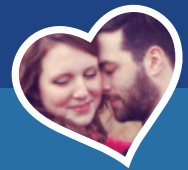
