

15th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME JULY 14, 2024

Sunday's Readings: Amos 7:12-15; Ps 85:9-10, 11-12, 13-14 (8); Ephesians 1:3-14 or 1:3-10; Mark 6:7-13

Gospel Reflection: Once I asked a fallen-away Catholic friend of mine what he remembered about the parish priest from his youth. He said, "He was a gentle, nice guy. Kind of vanilla. Kept to himself." It struck me that he,

perhaps like many, perceive Catholic priests as the following: lonely, harmless, and self-sufficient. As a challenge both to this perception (accurate or not) and to us priests who perhaps feel a pull in that uninspiring direction, stands the mighty image of what we see in the Gospel this Sunday.

Jesus sent out his apostles, "two-by-two, with power over demons, and without money belts." Two-by-two: they enjoyed deep fellowship and brotherhood. Power over demons: they were anything but harmless. These men wielded enormous power against evil. Without money belts: they were not self-sufficient. They needed others to help them. Not lonely, but in community. Not harmless but armed with massive spiritual energy. Not self-sufficient, but poor and in need of help.

This is a challenge to me, and perhaps to all of us, living in a rich, secularized, and individualized culture. Do I embrace my priestly ministry in deep fellowship with other priests? Do I speak and act boldly to drive out evil where it is found? Do I live poorly and simply, trusting in the help of those around me even for basic needs? The fruitfulness of priestly ministry largely depends on these three traits. Let's pray for all priests — and, by extension, all of us Christians — to live more like Jesus' communal, poor, and powerful apostles.

<u>Suy niệm</u>: Chúa Giê-su sai Nhóm Mười Hai đi rao giảng và chỉ thị cho các ông "không được mang gì đi đường, chỉ trừ cây gậy và đôi dép". Phải bỏ lại đàng sau không chỉ những hành trang linh kỉnh, mà cả những vật dụng hết sức cơ bản và thiết yếu cho cuộc sống cũng như cho hành trình sứ mạng. Chúa muốn dạy các tông đồ phải hoàn toàn tin tưởng, phó thác vào Chúa, chứ không cậy dựa vào những phương tiện của con người. Một lý do khác, đó là tính khẩn trương, cấp bách của sứ mạng: phải lên đường rao giảng ngay chứ không đợi đến lúc có đủ điều kiên, phương tiên mới loan báo Tin Mừng.

Mời Bạn: Quả thực, các phương tiện kỹ thuật giúp ích nhiều cho công cuộc loan báo Tin Mừng. This visit is part of the national program, in which annually a representative of one of the missionary groups visits parishes of the Diocese, to invite the Parish to share in the works of the Universal Church. Empowering Young Girls: From Poverty to a New Life in India

In this year's mission appeal on the weekend of July 13,14, we will learn how we can dramatically change the lives of poor girls in India. In Gandhinagar, Gujarat, India – a poverty-stricken area – Salesian sisters want to build a hostel that will house poor girls as they train for new careers and a real life. Without this hostel, girls will be married at 13 or 14 and have more children than they can care for. Or, a girl

could be traded for a pig, just to support a family. Or she could be captured by ruthless sex traffickers and condemned to a horrible life. With the hostel, she will have the chance for a real life, a real career. It is that simple and that dramatic.

Here are two village girls; both were born to grinding poverty in a poor Indian village.



One girl will never leave her village. \Longrightarrow She will drop out of school, be forced to marry young, and will work for \$3 a day at back-breaking labor for the rest of her life.


Hemlata, the other girl, trained by the sisters, is now on staff at a hospital. With your help, many more Hemlatas will have dignity, a good job and a real future.
