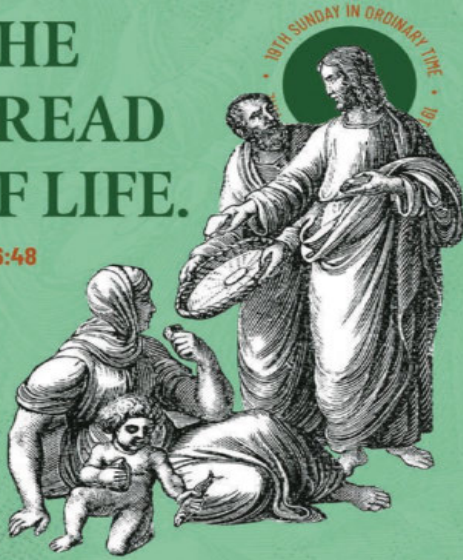

AUGUST 11, 2024

Sunday's Readings: 1 Kings 19:4-8; Ps 34:2-3, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9 (9a); Ephesians 4:30—5:2; John 6:41-51

Gospel Reflection : *This week we hear Jesus say, "He that believes in me, has eternal life" (John 6:47). These straightforward words, uttered by human lips, sound — how to put this? — insane. Who could possibly say such a thing? Jesus says things that are so high, so demanding, so beyond our capacity to fathom, we hardly know what to do with them and (if you're like me), they usually go in one ear and out the other. So, let us ask: how can believing in Him lead to eternal life?*

To believe in something means not just to acknowledge its existence, but also to orient yourself entirely to it. If a football player believes in his team, it means he puts his life totally at the service of that goal. If a student believes in her dream to become a doctor, she gives everything she has to her studies and preparation for her MCAT test. Belief means to move boldly toward something we love, and trust is possible to attain.

What is the highest possible good at which we can aim? It is God himself, the gift of eternal life without end. Jesus has made this "good" possible in and through his human nature. To believe in him means to have him as our ultimate goal. This week let's believe the truth of these words and make practical decisions to orient ourselves toward what we see available in him: eternal life.

Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary August 15th - Thursday (Holy day of Obligation)

This significant feast day recalls the spiritual and physical departure of the mother of Jesus Christ from the earth, when both her soul and her body were taken into the presence of God. Venerable Pope Pius XII confirmed this belief about the Virgin Mary as the perennial teaching of the Church when he defined it formally as a dogma of Catholic faith in 1950, invoking papal infallibility to proclaim, "that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." His Apostolic Constitution "Munificentissimus Deus" (Most Bountiful God), defines the dogma. Although the bodily assumption of Mary is not explicitly recorded in Scripture, Catholic tradition identifies her with the "woman clothed with the sun" who is described in the 12th chapter of the Book of Revelation.

Pope Pius XII hoped that by thinking about Mary's Assumption, people all over the world would develop a deeper respect for their own lives and would grow in respect for the lives of others.

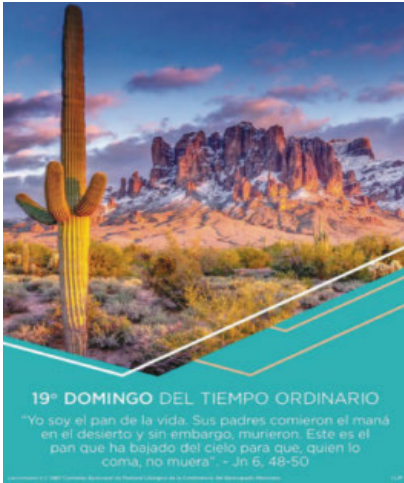

Los últimos domingos, el Evangelio nos muestra de diferentes maneras cómo Jesús es el Pan de Vida, y cómo podemos alcanzar grandes niveles de conocimiento en la fe y cómo vivir los valores auténticos del Evangelio. Sin embargo, la pregunta importante es la siguiente: ¿Qué podemos aprender de Dios y de sus enseñanzas en la época actual? ¿Qué significa para nosotros la Palabra de Dios? La respuesta es personal y amerita una reflexión profunda de parte de cada uno.

En la Eucaristía, Jesús se nos da como alimento; nos da la fuerza necesaria para continuar en el camino que aún nos queda por recorrer. Aprendamos a recibirla con respeto y veneración: ***"Yo soy el pan vivo que ha bajado del cielo. El que coma de este pan vivirá para siempre. El pan que yo daré es mi carne, y lo daré para la vida del mundo"*** (Juan 6:51).

Pidamos al Espíritu Santo, que nos ayude a comprender la inmensidad del amor de Jesús al darse como alimento. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica,

en el numeral 1324, no enseña lo siguiente: *"La Eucaristía es la fuente y la cima de toda la vida cristiana. Los demás sacramentos, como también todos los ministerios eclesiales y las obras de apostolado, están unidos a la Eucaristía y a ella se ordenan.*

La Sagrada Eucaristía, en efecto, contiene todo el bien espiritual de la Iglesia, es decir, Cristo mismo, nuestra Pascua". ©LPi

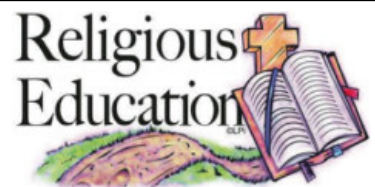

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XIX-MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN

Ga 6:41-51

THẦY BAN TRÓT THÂN MÌNH

Suy niệm: Trong trọn bản văn Thánh Lễ của Sách Lễ Rôma, những chữ được in đậm và to nhất chính là 'lời truyền phép': **"TẤT CẢ CÁC CON HÃY NHẬN LẤY MÀ ĂN, VÌ NÀY LÀ MÌNH THẦY, SẼ BỊ NỘP VÌ CÁC CON... TẤT CẢ CÁC CON HÃY NHẬN LẤY MÀ UỐNG, VÌ NÀY LÀ CHÉN MÁU THẦY, MÁU GIAO ƯỚC MỚI VÀ VĨNH CỬU, SẼ ĐỔ RA CHO CÁC CON VÀ NHIỀU NGƯỜI ĐƯỢC THA TỘI..."** In đậm và to nhất, bởi vì đây là những lời quan trọng nhất, đây là khoảnh khắc đậm đặc ý nghĩa YẾU THƯỜNG nhất của Thánh Lễ. Trong khoảnh khắc này, Chúa Giêsu dứt khoát trao hiến chính sự sống của Ngài cho chúng ta. Và đây không phải là một quyết định bốc đồng kiểu 'anh hùng rơm'; đây là cả một chương trình hiến thân được vạch ra từ trước, như bản văn Tin Mừng hôm nay xác nhận.

Mời Ban: Hãy nghe với cả tâm hồn mình, hãy nghe như lần đầu tiên được nghe những lời tha thiết của Chúa: *"Này là Mình Thầy sẽ bị nộp vì các con; này là Máu Thầy sẽ đổ ra cho các con..."* Và bạn hãy cảm nhận niềm hạnh phúc được Chúa yêu thương đến mức đó.

Chia sẻ: Hẳn bạn từng trao tặng điều gì thật quý cho bạn hữu, người thân? Hãy mô tả kinh nghiệm ấy. Rồi bạn nhìn lại hành động của Chúa: Ngài yêu thương ta đến mức trao chính bản thân, chính sự sống của Ngài chứ không phải chỉ là một cái gì đó ở ngoài Ngài!

Sống Lời Chúa: Bạn sốt sắng tham dự Thánh Lễ và rước lễ với cả tâm tình.

Câu nguyện: Hát *"Thầy yêu chúng con lời ai nói cho cùng... Thầy yêu chúng con Thầy ban trót thân mình, để nuôi chúng con ngày lưu ký trần gian..."*

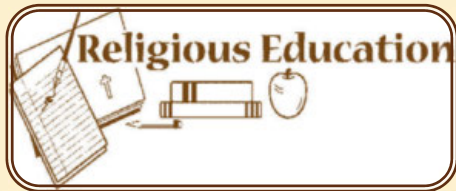

Youth Confirmation Program Registration for 2024-25

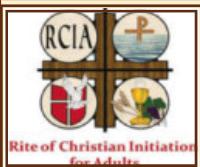

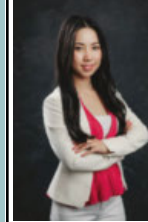

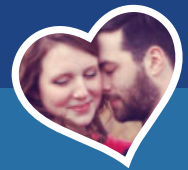
