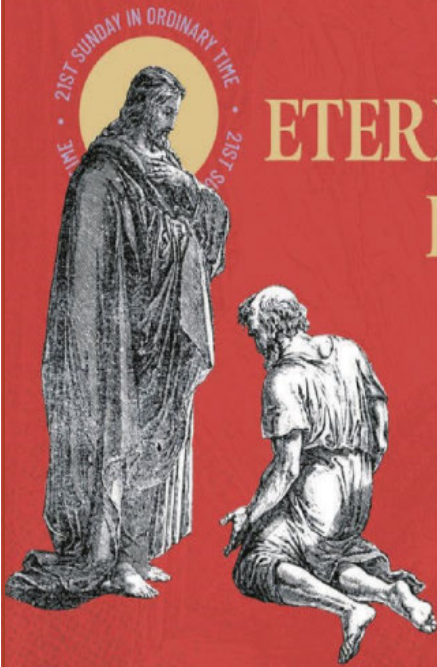

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

To Whom Shall We Go? A friend of mine, who is a far better Christian than I can ever hope to be, once shared with me that her family sneers at her belief system and lifestyle. She believes in fairy tales they tell her. She's looking for simple solutions from a kind-faced man in the sky because she doesn't want to grapple with complicated answers to complicated problems. Religion, they argue, is the easy way out.

As she spoke about this, her voice became unsteady. Not with anger, but with emotion. "I would never call this life easy," she said. "If I was looking for something that was easy, I wouldn't choose Catholicism." What was unspoken was why she has chosen Catholicism. I know the answer, but only because I know her. I knew her before she chose it wholeheartedly, and I know her now, and I see the difference. I see that these words are written so clearly across the days of her life: "Master, to whom shall we go?" Once the truth is known in your soul, you see, it can never be unknown.

Following Christ is not about easy answers and simple teachings. Sure, it all sounds very basic: love one another as I have loved you. What could be more straightforward? But what does that mean? What does that look like in daily, modern life, in a world full of the fallen, whose flaws have given us rough edges and weakened wills?

I'll tell you what it looks like — it looks like a struggle. It looks like failure and mess and confusion and losing your way and finding it again, all because you remembered that within you there is a compass pointing due north. It's a constant state of wandering in the dark, following a Voice that asks you to go where you're afraid to go. And you follow the Voice not because it's the only voice there is and not because it's the voice that says what you want to hear, but because it's the only one that speaks the truth, and the truth pulls on you in a way you can't quite resist. When Christ asks, "Do you also want to leave?" he is not gaslighting us. It's a genuine question. We are free to go. We are not prisoners.

But we have heard the words of everlasting life, and now we can only have peace if we follow where they lead.

Algunos de los seguidores de Jesús no pudieron creer lo que les dijo. Era demasiado para ellos: “*Mi carne es verdadera comida y mi sangre es verdadera bebida*” (Juan 6:55).

A pesar de que Jesús lo explicaba de muchas maneras, algunos decidieron abandonarlo. Él no hizo nada por detenerlos, los dejó libres respetando su decisión. Después de esos acontecimientos de abandono, Jesús pregunta directamente a los doce: “*¿Quiéren marcharse también ustedes? Pedro le contestó: Señor, ¿a quién iríamos? Tú tienes palabras de vida eterna. Nosotros creemos y sabemos que tú eres el Santo de Dios*”

(Juan 6:67-69). Ahora, en la realidad que vivimos tan llena de ruido y modernidad, ¿sabemos a dónde vamos, a quién dirigimos? Pedro, lo supo y el deseo de la Iglesia es que sepamos que solo Jesús tiene palabras de vida eterna. Y que su Pan de Vida se nos da gratuitamente en la Eucaristía.



“*La Eucaristía y la cruz son piedras de tropiezo. Es el mismo misterio, y no cesa de ser ocasión de división. ¿Quiéren marcharse también ustedes? (Juan 6:67): esta pregunta del Señor resuena a través de las edades, como invitación de su amor a descubrir que sólo Él tiene palabras de vida eterna (Juan 6:68), y que acoger en la fe el don de su Eucaristía es acogerlo a Él mismo*”. 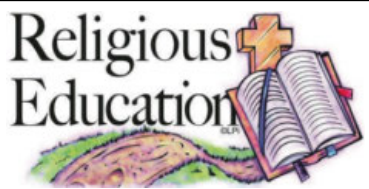

CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXI-MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN

Ga 6:54,60-69

MÀU NHIỆM VƯỢT QUÁ TRÍ HIỆU

Suy niệm: Không một con người bình thường nào dám tuyên bố thịt máu mình đem lại sự sống đời đời cho người khác. Chỉ có một vị Thiên Chúa quyền năng làm người mới dám long trọng xác quyết sự thật ấy, vì duy Ngài mới có được khả năng siêu phàm này. Ngài cũng xác quyết với ta rằng Ngài là Sự thật (Ga 14,6). Thịt Máu Ngài đem lại sự sống đời đời cho ta: đó là sự thật. Trong thánh lễ, mỗi khi rước Thịt Máu Ngài trong Bí tích Thánh Thể, ta không đón nhận thịt máu của một thân xác con người bình thường, nhưng là thân xác của Đấng Phục sinh. Chính thân xác phục sinh của vị Thiên Chúa hằng sống ấy có khả năng đem lại sự sống đời đời cho ta, khởi đầu hôm nay và kéo dài muôn đời trong thế giới vĩnh cửu.

Mời Ban: Chúa Giê-su thật sự ngự trong Bí tích Thánh Thể bằng chính Mình Máu Thánh Ngài là một màu nhiệm vượt quá tầm trí hiểu hạn hẹp của con người. Vấn đề là làm sao bạn rước Mình Máu Thánh Ngài cho xứng đáng, cũng như biến đổi con người bạn hôm nay, đem lại sự sống đời đời cho bạn? Để được vậy, bạn cần có lòng khao khát, ước ao rước Ngài trước khi lên rước lễ; cảm ơn sốt sắng sau khi rước lễ; nỗ lực trở nên giống Đấng mình đã lãnh nhận suốt ngày sống.

Sống Lời Chúa: Cung kính thờ lạy, tạ ơn, rước Chúa Giêsu vào lòng cách sốt sắng mỗi khi tham dự thánh lễ.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Chúa Giê-su, Chúa đã trời lại cho con bí tích Mình và Máu Thánh Chúa, để con đời đời tưởng nhớ Chúa đã chết, sống lại. Xin cho con biết một niềm sùng kính, mến yêu Bí tích kỳ diệu này, để luôn được nghiệm thấy ơn Chúa cứu chuộc con. Amen.*

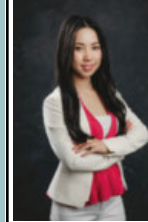

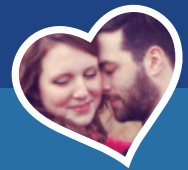
