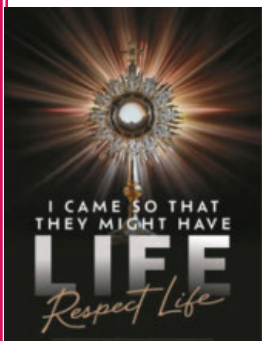

### Respect Life Sunday

Each October the Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life Month, and the first Sunday of October is observed as Respect Life Sunday.

The 2024 Respect Life poster features the Eucharist and Jesus' message in John 10:10, "I came so that they might have life." The placement of "Respect Life" beneath the verse conveys that Jesus' message and our response to it inherently include respect for human life. The design also reflects the importance of grounding efforts on behalf of life in the Holy Eucharist.



**Gospel Reflection** : People can spend their entire lives looking for their most suitable partner. Some have an unattainable ideal in their minds that makes the search impossible. Others may choose a different partner over and over again without any real discernment, leading to a long series of breakups and heartache. Perhaps the greatest obstacle for people lies in their assumption that the most important criteria for choosing a partner is that the person they choose to love needs to be devoted to them and be faithful to them above all others. The truth is that if you want to have a suitable partner who you find yourself drawing ever closer to as the years go by, then the focus of both people involved needs to be on a much more important being than the two of you.

When I was a teenager, I remember seeing a triangle used as a visual aid in explaining how true love works. God is the top point and the two lovers, friends, or family members involved are the bottom points. If the two involved in the relationship love God more than each other, then in time it will be their love for the Divine that will bring them ever closer, like how a triangle narrows at the top point.

The more I give of myself to my God, the greater I find my love is for my wife, my children, and my friends. A stewardship way of life will eventually strengthen all our relationships, for a surrender to the One who is love means an increase in the love we have to give to others. For those who continue to search for the "one," pause, pay attention, and see the One who has always loved you and will do so forevermore.

Y continúa diciendo en el numeral 1662: *“El matrimonio se funda en el consentimiento de los contrayentes, es decir, en la voluntad de darse mutua y definitivamente con el fin de vivir una alianza de amor fiel y fecundo. Pidamos siempre por los matrimonios porque es proyecto de Dios, que quiere que lo que él unió, no lo separemos.*

El salmo de hoy, nos dice que los mandamientos alegran el corazón de quien los practica y que son ley perfecta que reconforta el alma.

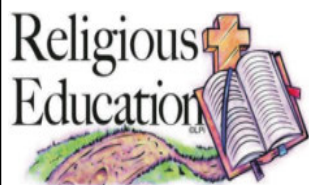

## CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXVII-MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN

**Mc 10:2-16**

## HÔN NHÂN LINH THÁNH

**Suy niệm:** Chúng ta có thể lấy làm lạ tại sao việc ly dị đã được luật Mô-sê cho phép (x. Đnl 24,1) mà người Pha-ri-sêu còn “hỏi thử” Chúa Giê-su có chấp nhận hay không. Nếu đã cho phép thì cứ theo luật mà thực hành, hà tất phải đặt vấn đề như thế làm chi nữa? Khoa chú giải Thánh Kinh cho biết trong nội bộ phái Pha-ri-sêu bấy giờ quả thực đang có tranh cãi kịch liệt về vấn đề này. Phải chăng tự thân tâm người ta vẫn ray rứt-dù đã có luật cho phép ly dị-khi họ “phân ly những gì Thiên Chúa đã kết hợp”? Chúa Giê-su cho biết hiện trạng của luật Mô-sê chỉ là một sự nhân nhượng vì họ “lòng chai dạ đá”. Ngài nhắc lại nguyên lý đã có ngay từ đầu: “*sự gì Thiên Chúa đã kết hợp, loài người không được phân ly*” để dứt khoát xoá bỏ quan điểm mập mờ cũng như lối thực hành du di của luật cũ và quả quyết rằng hôn nhân là thánh thiện và vô cùng cao quý.

**Mời Ban:** Xã hội hiện đại có xu hướng phá vỡ những giá trị văn hoá tốt đẹp của gia đình truyền thống: hôn nhân như chiếc bình thủy tinh mong manh dễ vỡ. Thực hành lời cam kết trong bí tích hôn nhân: “*yêu thương và kính trọng nhau suốt đời*” là viên đá góc để các gia đình Ki-tô hữu tân Phúc-Âm-hoá gia đình mình và để góp phần Phúc-Âm-hoá các gia đình lương dân.

**Sống Lời Chúa:** Sắp xếp thời gian để gia đình bạn đọc kinh chung và nhắc nhở nhau thực hành “*yêu thương và kính trọng nhau*” như lời cam kết.

**Cầu nguyện:** *Lạy Chúa, Chúa đã chúc phúc và thánh hoá mỗi giây liên kết vợ chồng. Xin cho các gia đình trung thành với lời cam kết hôn nhân để nên nhân chứng tình yêu Chúa ở giữa thế gian.*

## DỰ ÁN BẢO DƯỠNG GHẾ VÀ BÀN QUÝ

Tổng chi phí cho dự án bảo dưỡng và sửa chữa các dãy ghế và bàn quý là: **\$185,521.00 đô-la**.

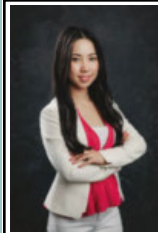

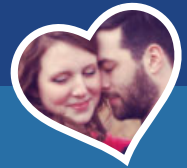
