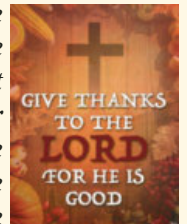

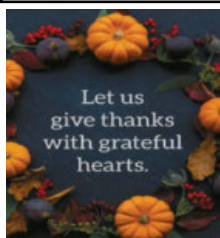

Con esta Solemnidad se termina el ciclo litúrgico B y daremos comienzo al ciclo C. Es decir, el próximo domingo daremos comienzo al tiempo de Adviento e iniciamos el nuevo Año Litúrgico. “Dios todopoderoso y eterno, que quisiste fundamentar todas las cosas en tu Hijo muy amado, Rey del universo, concede, benigno, que toda la creación, liberada de la esclavitud del pecado, sirva a tu majestad y te alabe eternamente (Oración Colecta). En la Primera lectura del Profeta Daniel se anuncia su reinado: “Su poder es el poder eterno que nunca pasará; su reino no será destruido” (Daniel 7:14). 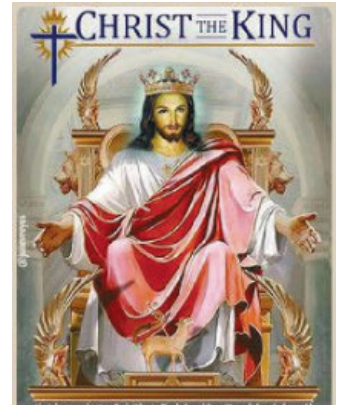
CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXXIV-MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN

Mc 18:33-37

LÀ CÔNG DÂN NƯỚC TRỜI

Suy niệm: Nhà thơ người Liban, K. Gibran có viết: “*Trước đây chúng ta tuân theo lệnh vua và quỳ mọp trước các hoàng đế. Thế nhưng ngày hôm nay chúng ta chỉ quỳ trước sự thật, chạy theo vẻ đẹp và vâng theo tình yêu.*” Đức Giê-su tuyên bố

với Phi-la-tô rằng Ngài là vua của một Nước. Tuy nhiên, Nước hay Vương Quốc ấy không thuộc trần gian này như những quốc gia thông thường, nhưng là một Nước đặc biệt độc nhất vô nhị. Đặc biệt vì đó là Nước của Sự Thật. Trong Nước Sự Thật của Ngài, người ta sẽ không còn dùng những thủ đoạn chính trị giả dối, nhưng dựa trên nền tảng là sự thật. Các công dân của Nước này can đảm sống cho sự thật, chết cho sự thật. Đó cũng là Nước của Tình Yêu vì địa vị cao trọng của mỗi công dân dựa trên yêu thương: yêu thương là luật lệ chi phối mọi sinh hoạt, càng yêu nhiều, càng cao trọng.



Mời Ban: Hôm nay Vua Giê-su hỏi bạn: “*Con có muốn Ta làm Vua của con không?*” Chọn Ngài làm vua là không chọn sống theo những giá trị của thế gian (tiền bạc, bạo lực, hận thù, tham lam...) nhưng theo những giá trị Tin Mừng của Vương Quốc Sự Thật và Tình Yêu. Bạn sẽ trả lời “vâng” với câu hỏi của Chúa bằng cách nào?

Sống Lời Chúa: Là công dân của Vương Quốc Sự Thật và Tình Yêu, tôi sẽ nỗ lực đem những giá trị của Tin Mừng (sự thật, yêu thương, công bằng...) thâm nhập vào môi trường mình đang sống.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Vua Giê-su, chúng con hạnh phúc được làm công dân của Nước Chúa. Xin cho chúng con cố gắng làm chứng cho sự thật này: Thiên Chúa là Cha yêu thương nhân loại. Amen.*

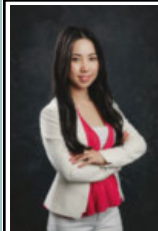

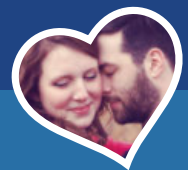
