Gospel Reflection : The Light of the Moon

If you own a television that has been turned on at any point in the last month or so, chances are you've caught at least a scene or two of the 1946 classic film "It's a Wonderful Life." If you're not familiar with the movie, it follows the life of George Bailey from childhood through adulthood. A dreamer by nature, George has big plans for himself that involve world exploration and adventure — but family and community obligations keep him tethered to the same spot on the map, leading an altogether ordinary life.

One of the most memorable scenes from that movie is of George dancing with his sweetheart Mary while they sing "Buffalo Gals — Won't you come out tonight/And dance by the light of the moon?" That lyric always catches my ear. Of course, the moon doesn't have any light of its own. All the moon has is the ability to reflect the light that shines upon it.

The same holds for us, doesn't it? Our stewardship is purely a reflection of the grace granted to us by another. "Upon you the LORD shines," writes Isaiah, "and over you appears his glory." Every good action we will ever take begins in the mind of God. The fact that we have the honor of carrying it out on His behalf is a beautiful gift. It is God that makes our ordinary lives extraordinary.

In the end of the movie, George Bailey realizes that he had a far greater life because, instead of being the hero of his own story, he allowed himself to reflect goodness onto others.

Remember — the magi didn't chart their own course. They merely followed the star.

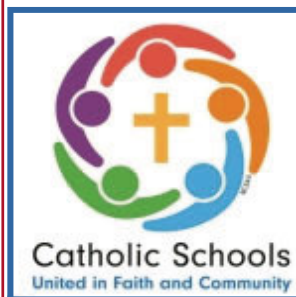
Vietnamese Lunar New Year - 2025

Reflexión del Evangelio: La Luz de la Luna

Estamos aún en un ambiente navideño, la alegría perdura todavía en nuestro corazón y en el ambiente. El Evangelio nos narra que los Magos, obedeciendo la voz de su conciencia y guiados por una estrella, se ponen en marcha. Deseaban reconocer a Dios para ofrecerle sus regalos de oro, incienso y mirra. Después de investigar y preguntar, se aseguran de continuar el camino. Su esfuerzo no fue en vano, ellos fueron capaces de encontrarlo: *“Al entrar a la casa vieron al niño con María, su madre; se arrodillaron y le adoraron”* (Mateo 2:11). ¿Cuáles han sido mis esfuerzos en esta Navidad para encontrar a Dios? ¿A quien he preguntado para ser guiado y llegar a Él? Para ver el misterio de Dios, debemos prepararnos. Esto implica movimiento, bondad, y sencillez. Solo así, experimentaremos la grandeza de Dios y lograremos ver nuestra pequeñez. Callar y percibir el ambiente del Evangelio de esta Liturgia es esencial para una limpieza del corazón. Es tiempo de abandonar la terquedad de nuestra vida, la desconfianza e hipocresía que a veces tenemos guardada como Herodes. *“Se dejaron guiar por el impulso de la luz celeste y mientras acompañaban con atenta contemplación la luz que los precedía, eran guiados al conocimiento de la verdad por el esplendor de la gracia”* (San León Magno, Primer sermón de la Epifanía). Todos estamos invitados y tenemos derecho de mirar al cielo como los Magos y buscar la estrella que nos guía en el camino: ¡Jesús! ©LPi

NGÔI SAO GIÊ-SU

Suy niệm: Đường dẫn các đạo sĩ đến Bê-lem là con đường của SAO. SAO rọi chiếu ánh sáng cho đường đi, SAO nuôi hy vọng, SAO cho biết Đấng được sinh ra sẽ mang sứ mệnh lịch sử quan trọng. SAO có lúc khuất dạng nhưng không vụt tắt, có lúc bị mây mù che phủ nhưng rồi lại lộ dạng và đồng hành. Ngôi sao trên bầu trời đầu có lạ lùng cũng chỉ là dấu hiệu chỉ đường đến với Hài Nhi Giê-su, là NGÔI SAO đích thực dẫn đường cho không riêng cho các đạo sĩ mà còn cho cả loài người và từng người trong suốt dọc dài lịch sử. Đó chính là nỗi vui mừng khôn xiết của những ai biết tìm đường đến với Chúa Giê-su, hiện thân của mầu nhiệm Con Thiên Chúa nhập thể làm người.

Mời Ban: Người thời nay sùng mộ nhiều thứ thần tượng, và khi thần tượng ấy sụp đổ, họ vỡ mộng, thất vọng. Trên con đường tìm về Chân-Thiện-Mỹ, ngôi SAO dẫn đường cho chúng ta chỉ có thể là Chúa Giê-su mà thôi vì Ngài “là Con Đường, là Sự Thật và là Sự Sống.” Dầu có lúc ngôi SAO của chúng ta dường như vụt tắt, chúng ta không hoang mang chao đảo bởi vì Ngài chỉ ẩn mình nhưng vẫn hiện diện, chịu chết nhưng đã sống lại và Ngài hằng sống.

Sống Lời Chúa: Suy niệm Lời Chúa hằng ngày để chiêm ngưỡng và trở nên giống ngôi sao thần tượng của mình là Chúa Giê-su Ki-tô.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Chúa Giê-su Hài Đồng, Chúa là Ngôi SAO và Thần Tượng của con. Con không có vàng để dâng cho Chúa; nhưng con dâng Chúa tâm lòng của con. Xin Chúa mãi là người bạn đường, là ngôi SAO soi dẫn đời con.*

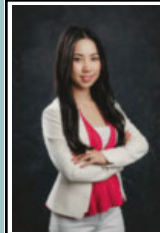

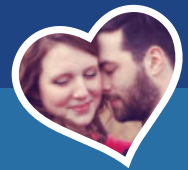
