Gospel Reflection : The Baptism of the Lord

In my second year of theology studies, I went to confession to a priest visiting the seminary for a three-day retreat. My heart wasn't in it. I was going through the motions. I confessed my sins and waited for his response. The priest said, "For your penance, I'd like you to go into the chapel and repeat the words 'You are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased' (Luke 3:22) until they mean something to you." Easy penance, I thought.

But to my surprise, I struggled to say those words. I sensed a strong interior resistance blocking them. How could God be well-pleased with me? He couldn't be, I thought. A battle within me ensued. Two hours later, the resistance vanished, and I found myself able to speak, and claim as my own, those marvelous words. I emerged from the chapel with a new, deep, peaceful conviction that I was indeed God's beloved son.

Those words are a precious gift from heaven to all of us. Jesus' baptism, which we celebrate this week, offers them to us. Are we willing to receive these words anew? Many things can block this deepening of our baptismal identity: failings, sins, disappointments, traumas, problems, and so on. Yet God's love is always greater. This week I challenge you to prayerfully repeat these words over yourself — or perhaps over someone you're struggling to love — until those words find a home in your heart.

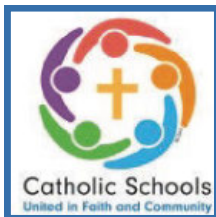
Walk for Life West Coast 2025

Reflexión del Evangelio | El Bautismo del Señor

Si pudiéramos recordar nuestro propio Bautismo, tal vez sentiríamos algo muy especial sobre la invitación de Dios a sentirnos predilectos hijos e hijas amados por Dios. Ahí, en la pila bautismal, ese día tan especial, recibimos el Espíritu Santo. Ojalá, hoy estemos dispuestos a escuchar en nuestro corazón las mismas palabras que Jesús escuchó en el Río Jordán: "Tú eres mi Hijo, hoy te he dado la vida" (Lucas 3:22). LỄ CHÚA GIÊ-SU CHỊU PHÉP RỬA

Lc 3:15-16,21-22

NHẬN MÌNH LÀ TỘI NHÂN

Suy niệm: Trong khi loài người kiêu ngạo tự nâng mình lên thì Con Thiên Chúa thánh thiện lại tự hạ mình xuống. Trong khi xu hướng loài người là che dấu tội mình, thì Con Thiên Chúa lại công khai xếp mình vào hàng tội nhân, tự nguyện ghé vai gánh hết tội lỗi và mọi hình phạt mà đáng ra loài người phải chịu. Con Thiên Chúa chịu phép rửa như thể Ngài là một tội nhân, bởi vì đó chính là ý muốn của Thiên Chúa, Cha của Ngài mà Ngài luôn luôn sẵn sàng vâng phục. Và do đó, Người thật xứng đáng được nghe lời Chúa Cha nói với mình: “*Con là Con yêu dấu của Cha, Cha hài lòng về Con*” (Mc 1,11).

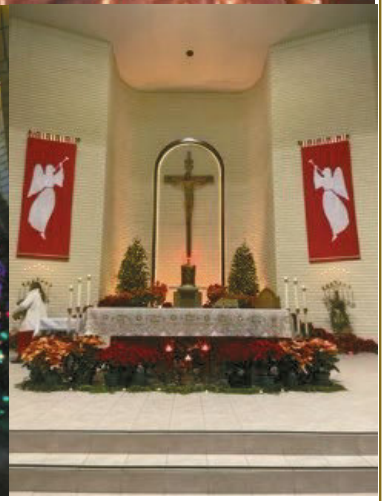
Mỗi Ban: Việc Đức Giê-su chịu phép rửa tại sông Gio-đan nhắc chúng ta nhớ tới thân phận tội lỗi của mình. Chúng ta mang trong mình tội truyền từ nguyên tổ A-đam và cả tội riêng mình. Tất cả những tội lỗi ấy đều phát xuất từ tính kiêu ngạo. Đức Giê-su, vốn không có tội, đã tự hạ bằng một cuộc “đi xuống”. Loài người chúng ta hay kiêu ngạo tự xếp mình vào một chỗ cao hơn mình đáng. Bởi đó, chúng ta cần làm một cuộc “đi xuống” đứng vào vị trí tội nhân của mình và xin được tái thanh tẩy bằng bí tích Hòa Giải. Được như vậy, chúng ta cũng sẽ được Chúa Cha nói với chúng ta: “*Con là con yêu dấu của Cha, Cha hài lòng về con.*”

Sống Lời Chúa: Thường xuyên xét mình để ý thức hơn về thân phận tội lỗi của mình và luôn sống khiêm nhường.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Chúa Giê-su, Chúa vốn không có tội mà tự nguyện hạ mình xuống, đứng vào hàng tội nhân. Còn chúng con vốn là những tội nhân và kiêu ngạo tự nâng mình lên. Xin cho chúng con thấy rõ mình mà tự khiêm tự hạ.*

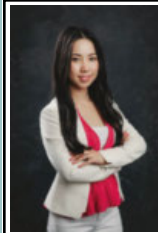

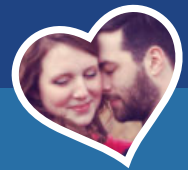
