Why Are We Looking at the Sky?

Men of Galilee — why are you looking at the sky? It seems like a pretty foolish question for the angels to be asking the disciples. Their best friend just flew away in a cloud. I think in that situation, my first reaction would probably be to stop and stare, too.



But let's not forget, the disciples had a lot of work to do. A world full of souls to evangelize. I've always been a little amused at the thought of the angels shooing them down from Mount Olivet. Get to work! The kingdom isn't going to build itself!

In our own faith lives, we often find ourselves looking at the sky, don't we? We're the faithful, after all. We have seen Christ. We have accepted him. We have given ourselves to him. What more do we need to do? Perhaps we excessively dwell on the past, or anxiously anticipate the future. 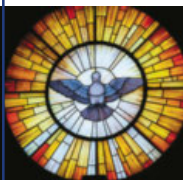

LỄ CHÚA THĂNG THIÊN

Lc 24:46-53

CHÚA VỀ TRỜI, CON ĐƯỢC SAI ĐI

Suy niệm: Các tông đồ ngậy ngất chiêm ngưỡng vinh quang của Chúa Ki-tô và say sưa với hạnh phúc ngọt ngào khi được chứng kiến Chúa thăng thiên đến độ các ông quên mất sứ mạng Chúa trao vẫn còn đó. Chúa sai thiên sứ đến “đánh thức” các ông và nhắc lại: lệnh truyền cho các ông xuống núi và ra đi loan báo Tin Mừng Phục Sinh. “*Đi đến vùng ngoại biên*” là kiểu nói mà cổ Đức Giáo Hoàng Phan-xi-cô dùng, để nhắc lại lệnh truyền của Đức Ki-tô cho mọi thành phần Dân Chúa phải ra khỏi chính mình để đến với thế giới: “*phải nhân danh Chúa rao giảng cho muôn dân, bắt đầu từ Giê-ru-sa-lem... Chính anh em là chứng nhân về những điều này.*”

Mời Ban: Nhiều ki-tô hữu hôm nay khi suy niệm việc “*Chúa Giê-su lên trời,*” cũng xin cho được “*ai mộ những sự trên trời,*” nhưng khi nói đến sứ mệnh được sai đi, xuống núi để đem Tin Mừng của Chúa đến anh chị em mình nơi láng giềng, trong khu xóm mình sinh sống thì lại “ngại” hoặc không biết phải nói gì để “*trả lời cho bất cứ ai chất vấn về niềm hy vọng của anh em*” (1Pr 3,15). “*Hãy ra đi bình an*” là lời cầu chúc của Giáo hội gởi đến mỗi người tín hữu. Nhờ vậy, chúng ta biết bước ra khỏi chính mình để đến với anh em mà đem Tin Mừng Phục sinh cho họ. Mong sao mỗi người tín hữu đều biết đáp lại lời mời gọi này.

Sống Lời Chúa: Bạn thăm viếng một người quen, một gia đình lân cận để chia sẻ tình thân, và bạn nhớ cầu nguyện cùng Chúa cho họ.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Chúa, xin thúc bách con để luôn quan tâm loan báo Tin Mừng cứu độ cho anh chị em con.*

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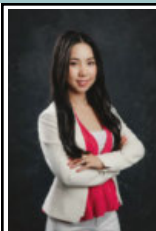
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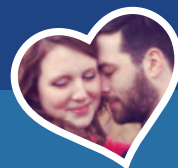
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
