Pentecost Sunday - Reflection John 20:19-23

When I was a seminarian almost 20 years ago, a bank vice president taught us etiquette classes. She said, "Gentlemen, please make sure your breath isn't bad. Take some breath mints before you hear confessions, okay?" We nervously laughed because the proximity that makes breath noticeable (whether pleasant or not) can be a bit awkward.

When Jesus breathes on his Apostles (John 20:22), he must have been within inches of at least some of them. This closeness of his breath has a purpose: the purpose of forgiveness of sins. **"Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them"** (John 20:23). Why in the world would the almost uncomfortable closeness of his breath forgive sins?

In the Bible, breath is spirit or wind. It comes from above and makes that which is below to have identity. To not have a single identity is to be multiple, divided. The word "sin" comes from an ancient word that means "to split" or "render asunder." Sin divides us sinners and the world around us; our spiritual "breath" leaves us and our identity splinters. Only breath from above restores. For example, a shattered vase is rendered whole because the craftsman breathes the spirit of the vase back into it when he repairs it. A human being shattered by sin is made whole by the breath of God, breathed by Jesus through his priests. His breath alone forgives sins. It's always done with his gentle, loving closeness.

Domingo de Pentecostés

Este día de Pentecostés tenemos la oportunidad de pedir al Espíritu Santo que abra las puertas de nuestro corazón, nos regale la paz, y que seamos portadores de ella a dondequiera que nos presentemos. Hoy en día, el mundo, más que nunca, necesita la paz. Hay guerra y destrucción en varios países, dando como resultado vivir deseando la paz. La gente sufre atrapada en la incertidumbre y el miedo. Ojalá que hoy escuchemos este mensaje y se hagan realidad para muchas personas estas palabras: *“Jesús les volvió a decir: ¡La paz esté con ustedes!”* (Juan 20:21). A otro le ilumina la mente con el don de profecía. A otro le da el poder de arrojar demonios. LỄ CHÚA THÁNH THẦN HIỆN XUỐNG

Ga 20:19-23

NHẬN LẤY TINH THẦN ĐỨC KI-TÔ

Suy niệm: Chúa Giê-su ban Thánh Thần cho các tông đồ ngay trong ngày Chúa phục sinh. Như một cuộc sáng tạo mới, Chúa Ki-tô phục sinh ban Thánh Thần qua việc “thổi hơi” trên các ông, một hình ảnh nói lên việc Chúa truyền “tinh thần” của Ngài cho các tông đồ. Nhờ cùng một “tinh thần” với Chúa, các tông đồ trở nên giống Chúa, nên một với Ngài, và nhờ đó, các tông đồ được nên một với nhau. Chúa Thánh Thần, “tinh thần” của Đức Ki-tô chính là Đấng nối kết, hiệp nhất mọi người trong thân thể máu nhiệm Chúa Ki-tô. Nhờ sống trong Thánh Thần, chúng ta có được cảm thức về Hội Thánh.

Mời Ban: Bạn đã có cảm thức về Hội Thánh ở giáo xứ bạn đang sống chưa? Nghĩa là bạn có cảm thấy “tinh thần” của Đức Ki-tô hoạt động nơi các tín hữu là chi thể của Hội Thánh tại giáo xứ của bạn không? Sống theo “tinh thần của Đức Ki-tô” là thực hiện sứ mạng của mình theo những đòi hỏi của bí tích Rửa Tội và Thêm Sức.

Sống Lời Chúa: – cầu nguyện cho Hội Thánh tại giáo xứ luôn được hiệp nhất; – cuối mỗi ngày xét mình để kiểm điểm xem mình có sống theo tinh thần của Đức Ki-tô không.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Chúa, xin hiệp nhất chúng con nên một trong tình yêu Chúa. Xin Chúa Thánh Thần soi sáng hướng dẫn mọi hành động của con, để con có thể góp phần xây dựng sự hiệp nhất trong Hội Thánh Chúa. Amen.*

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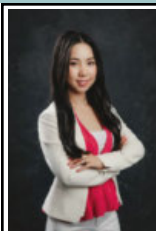
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
