

What We Store in the Barn

I once knew a godly woman who had truly tasted the bitterness of this earthly life. This woman knew pain. She knew sacrifice. She knew hard labor and loss, including the death of a cherished child. She worked each day at a low-paying job, waiting patiently for her 65th birthday, when she could retire and devote herself full-time to her grandchildren. She crossed off the dwindling days on her calendar like a first grader waiting for Christmas.

Ninety-eight days before she was set to retire, she died suddenly. Her name was erased from the schedule at work and penciled over with that of her replacement hire.

I think we all know someone like this, don't we? If the details aren't exactly the same, the outline of the story is: someone labors "with wisdom and knowledge and skill," in the words of Ecclesiastes. And what profit comes to him? Sorrow and grief all his days. The proverbial barn filled with harvest and left to rot.

But I'll let you in on a secret: this isn't a sad story. I've only told you part of it. This woman heard, daily, the voice of God, and against it she never hardened her heart, whatever news it brought her. This woman loved as hard as she worked. Every action was a form of evangelization. To talk to her was to feel the embrace of Christ.

As much as she waited for that retirement that never came, it was never the harvest in her barn.

This is what it means to be a true steward: to seek what is above.

**Considering becoming Catholic ?
Then consider OCIA (the Order of Christian
Initiation of Adults)**

Last year at the Easter Vigil our church grew - 12 more candidates were initiated to the faith. Many others we are sure wish to learn more about our faith. OCIA is the process for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation - Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. It is designed to fully incorporate a person into the Church. If you or someone you know is interested in learning more about the Catholic Church, now is the time!

At St. Felicitas, a new OCIA session will begin in August. The OCIA process goes through distinct phases and rites. **Alpha** (September–November): Explore the basics of Christianity in an open, friendly environment. **Sacramental Preparation** : Prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation. **Adult Faith Formation** : Grow in your faith and learn to live it daily. (Also known as Mystagogy in OCIA.)

We will have orientation on August 12th at 6:30 pm and classes will begin on August 26th at 6:30 pm. Both will be held at the St. Joseph's Center.

Lo que almacenamos en el granero - Una vez conocí a una piadosa mujer que verdaderamente había probado la amargura de esta vida terrenal. Esta mujer conocía el dolor. Ella conocía el sacrificio. Conoció el trabajo duro y la pérdida, incluida la muerte de un niño querido. Trabajaba todos los días en un trabajo mal pagado, esperando pacientemente su cumpleaños número 65, cuando podría jubilarse y dedicarse tiempo completo a sus nietos. Ella tachaba los días menguantes en su calendario como una niña de primer grado que espera la Navidad.

Noventa y ocho días antes de su jubilación, murió repentinamente. Su nombre fue borrado del horario en el trabajo y escrito encima el nombre de su reemplazo.

Creo que todos conocemos a alguien así, ¿no? Si los detalles no son exactamente los mismos, el esquema de la historia lo es: alguien trabaja "con su talento, ciencia, y habilidad," en palabras del Eclesiastés. ¿Y qué provecho le viene a él? Tristeza y dolor todos sus días. El granero proverbial se llenó de cosecha y se dejó pudrir.

Pero te contaré un secreto: esta no es una historia triste. Solo te he contado una parte. Esta mujer escuchaba, diariamente, la voz de Dios, y contra ella nunca endureció su corazón, cualquiera que fuera la noticia que le traía. Esta mujer amaba tanto como trabajaba. Cada acción era una forma de evangelización. Hablar con ella era sentir el abrazo de Cristo.

Por más que esperó ese retiro que nunca llegó, nunca fue la cosecha en su granero.

Esto es lo que significa ser un verdadero corresponsable: buscar lo que está arriba.

Phải Coi Chùng

Suy niệm: Vị đại gia trong bài dụ ngôn thật đáng khen vì đã khéo làm ăn để có được một mùa bội thu. Thế nhưng ông ta đã tính sai về thời hạn tận hưởng những hoa lợi đó. Ông nghĩ rằng với các kho lẫm chứa đầy thóc lúa, ông có thể sống an nhàn trong nhiều năm. Thế nhưng, ông không thể định đoạt được tuổi thọ mạng sống của ông, chủ thể tận hưởng. Nếu bất chợt trong đêm, lúc ông không ngờ, từ thân đến gỗ cửa nhà ông, những kho lẫm kia vụt khỏi tay ông để trao về cho người khác, có khi không mất công gầy dựng. Của cải vật chất dù có nhiều đến mấy cũng không bảo đảm cuộc sống dài lâu cho con người.
