

First Sunday of Advent - Hope
Sunday's Readings: : Isaiah 2:1-5; Ps 122:1-2, 3-4, 4-5, 6-7, 8-9; Romans 13:11-14; Matthew 24:37-44

Sunday Reflection :

“So too, you also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come.”

This week we hear that ominous Gospel passage where Jesus tells us about people being taken from where they are and what they are doing when they least expect it, while others remain. This has been distorted by some for support into a spectacular idea of rapture, leading to many books and movies. A profitable genre has been created that sometimes preys on people's fears.

But in following Jesus Christ, there is no fear. What we are called to do is live each day as it were our last. Be mindful of all the opportunities around you to share love and the gifts God has given you. We will all be held accountable in the end, but it is not what we have done that will save us. Our salvation lies in the grace freely given to us by Jesus. When we choose to receive that gift and intentionally follow him, we are led to giving over our entire being totally to him.

This Advent, let's not allow ourselves to be caught up in all the craziness of the season, but instead give ourselves over to God to use for His glory.

The Incarnation born in a manger is calling you. Have no fear.

CHÚA NHẬT I-MÙA VỌNG

Mt 24:37-44

TỈNH THỨC VÀ SẴN SÀNG

Suy niệm: Ngày cánh chung, ngày Chúa Giê-su trở lại phán xét trần gian là ngày nào? Đây là câu hỏi làm bận tâm các môn đệ không chỉ trong thời Chúa Ki-tô mà còn cả trong thời đại chúng ta. Chúa dạy các môn đệ việc biết rõ thời gian cụ thể, ngày nào giờ nào sẽ diễn ra cuộc phán xét chung, điều đó không quan trọng bằng thái độ chúng ta đón chờ việc đó diễn ra. Ngày ấy bao giờ sẽ đến, không ai biết được trừ ra Chúa Cha, chỉ biết chắc một điều là nó sẽ đến và "đến như kẻ trộm ban đêm" (x. 1Tx 5,1; 2Pr 3,10). Chính vì vậy, việc canh thức, sự chuẩn bị tâm hồn cách liên li là thái độ của con cái Chúa, thái độ của những trinh nữ khôn ngoan luôn sẵn sàng cầm "đèn sáng" trong tay đón chàng rể đến lúc đêm khuya (x. Mt 25,1-13).

Mời Ban: Bạn có thật sự "đang" canh thức bằng thái độ sống của con cái Chúa ngay giữa cuộc sống bận rộn trăm bề này chưa? Thái độ canh thức đó là: "gác lại" cuộc sống bận rộn, "siêng năng" đến với Chúa qua các bí tích Giao Hòa, Thánh Thể, để được lãnh nhận ơn tha thứ và sự sống sung mãn vĩnh cửu từ Đấng Cứu Độ là Chúa Giê-su Ki-tô.

Sống Lời Chúa: Khởi đầu Mùa Vọng này, tôi đặt tôi trước mặt Chúa, để xét mình, xưng tội và quyết tâm từ bỏ một thói xấu cụ thể.

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Thiên Chúa, xin lấy lòng nhân hậu xót thương con, mở lượng hải hà, xóa tội con đã phạm; xin dùng cành hương thảo rửa nước thanh tẩy con, con sẽ được tinh tuyền; xin rửa con cho sạch con sẽ trắng hơn tuyết; xin tạo cho con một tấm lòng trong trắng, đổi mới tinh thần cho con nên chung thủy.* (Tv 51, 3. 9.12).
