

33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time



Sunday's Readings: Malachi 3:19-20a; Ps 98:5-6, 7-8, 9 (see 9); 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12; Luke 21:5-19

**Reflection** : When I was a kid growing up in New England, I'd occasionally go on a whale watch. Once we went out with calm waters and clear skies. But on the way back in, the sea got rough. I was just a kid, and

I remember thinking we should turn left or right toward the shoreline I could see. But the pilot of the boat kept going straight — right into the waves — focused on a small, discouragingly distant lighthouse. Even when it flickered in and out of sight, he stayed the course. He knew where he was going.

That image comes to mind when I hear Jesus' words in today's Gospel regarding false messiahs: **"Do not follow them"** (Luke 21:8). In times of chaos or uncertainty, there are always voices offering easier routes, promising false safety, claiming to speak for God. But Jesus isn't found in the loudest voice or the nearest shoreline. He is steady, like a lighthouse in the storm.

The tribulation of which Jesus speaks — it's real. It happened to the Temple, it happened to him, it happens in the Church, and it will come to each of us. But the command is not to panic. It's to endure. To keep steering toward him. Faith isn't about having all the answers or dodging every wave. It's about knowing where the lighthouse is — and trusting it enough to keep going, especially when false safety beckons us to stop.

## CHÚA NHẬT TUẦN XXXIII-MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN

Lc 21:5-19

### THÁNH HIẾN ĐỀN THỜ

**Suy niệm:** Năm 70 sau Công Nguyên, sau khi chiếm thành Giê-ru-sa-lem, tướng Rô-ma là Titô đã cho phóng hỏa đốt thành và cho cày một luống cày chính giữa Đền thờ. Thế là chấm dứt ngôi Đền thờ nổi tiếng, để rồi trong gần 2.000 năm, câu chúc luôn nằm trên môi miệng người Do Thái là “Hẹn năm sau về Giê-ru-sa-lem”. Những lời tiên tri của Đức Giê-su đã được ứng nghiệm! Thế nhưng, với con mắt đức tin, ta khám phá ra một ý nghĩa khác về ngôi đền thờ như Đức Giê-su nói: “Hãy phá hủy đền thờ này và trong ba ngày, Tôi sẽ xây dựng lại”. Từ nay ngôi đền thờ vĩnh cửu mọi người phải qui hướng về là con người Đức Giê-su phục sinh. Mọi người đều được mời gọi bước vào Đền thờ-Đức Ki-tô phục sinh để gặp gỡ Thiên Chúa.

**Mời Bạn:** Nhớ rằng thân xác mỗi người cũng là đền thờ Thiên Chúa. Phải qui hướng, gắn bó với Đức Ki-tô và Thánh Thần của Ngài. Cần thường xuyên thanh tẩy đền thờ-tâm hồn bằng ơn thánh của bí tích hoà giải.

**Sống Lời Chúa:** Tôi luôn kính trọng thân xác, không quá chiều chuộng, cũng chẳng khinh rẻ vì ý thức thân xác mình là đền thờ của Thiên Chúa.

**Cầu nguyện:** Lạy Chúa Giê-su, xin dẫn con vào nhà của con, căn nhà của trái tim, căn nhà vừa quen vừa lạ.
