January 11, 2026 The Baptism of the Lord

*Sunday's Readings: Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7; Ps 29:1-2, 3-4, 3, 9-10;
Acts 10:34-38; Matthew 3:13-17*

The Baptism of the Lord - Reflection

Apple ran a commercial not long ago called "Behind the Mac – Greatness." It shows artists and creators, such as Kendrick Lamar, Billie Eilish, and Lady Gaga, working behind their MacBooks. The narration says, "There's a certain kind of person who doesn't wait for greatness. They make it." It's a compelling message. There's beauty in using our gifts with passion and purpose. But there lies a hidden

weight in that idea: If you are what you make, what happens when you can't anymore? When the project fails, the passion fades, or the spotlight moves on, where is greatness then?

*Today's Gospel offers a differing vision of greatness. Jesus steps into the Jordan River. He hasn't preached, healed, or performed a single miracle. Then the heavens open, and the Father speaks: **"You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."** It's not a reward for success. It's not earned. Before he does anything "great," Jesus receives the greatness of His identity from the Father. And so do you. At your baptism, God said the same thing over you: "You are my beloved." That is your true identity, not constructed or earned but received. When we see ourselves and others this way, everything changes for the better. We discover a greatness that can never be taken away.*

This week, reflect on your baptism: look up the date, thank God for it, pray for those baptized with you, or visit the church where it happened. Let your identity be rooted there.

EL Bautismo del Señor - Mateo 3:13-17

Las lecturas de hoy nos presentan al prometido por Dios desde el Antiguo Testamento. Al ser bautizado por Juan, Jesús asume su misión pública, nada fácil, por cierto. Sin embargo, no está solo. El Espíritu Santo lo acompañará a lo largo de su vida y misión. “En ese momento se abrieron los cielos y vio al Espíritu de Dios que bajaba como una paloma y se posaba sobre él. Al mismo tiempo, se oyó una voz del cielo que decía: ‘Este es mi Hijo, el Amado; en él me complazco’”. (Mateo 3:16-17). 

LỄ CHÚA GIÊ-SU CHỊU PHEP RỬA

Mt 3:13-17

NGÀI ĐƯA TÔI LÊN CAO

Suy niệm: Trước hành động liên đới của Thiên Chúa dành cho con người, chúng ta có thể lấy cảm nghiệm sâu xa của Monier mà giải thích: *"Thiên Chúa yêu thương con người, không phải vì con người xứng đáng với tình yêu. Nhưng con người xứng đáng với tình yêu Thiên Chúa bởi vì Thiên Chúa yêu thương con người."* Thực vậy, chỉ có tình yêu mới cắt nghĩa được lý do Chúa Giê-su liên đới với chúng ta. Theo luật Do Thái, những người tội lỗi, bị bệnh phong hủi phải hét lớn cảnh báo không để ai đến gần liên lụy với mình. Còn Chúa Giê-su lại chọn đứng xếp hàng chung với những người tội lỗi để liên đới với họ trong mọi nỗi khổn cùng và yếu hèn. Cần lưu ý, Ngài đến giữa tội nhân không phải để bình thường hóa tội lỗi, nói cách khác, Ngài đến không vì tội lỗi, nhưng vì chúng ta và để cứu rỗi chúng ta. Do đó, ngõ ngàng trước tình yêu của Thiên Chúa bao nhiêu, người ta càng dùng ơn sức Ngài ban để chiến đấu chống trả tội lỗi bấy nhiêu.
