

February 22, 2026 - 1st Sunday in Lent
Sunday's Readings: Genesis 2:7-9; 3:1-7; Ps 51:3-4, 5-6, 12-13, 17;
Romans 5:12-19 or 5:12, 17-19; Matthew 4:1-11

Reflection :*Can you believe Lent is here already? It seems like not that long ago I was decorating a Christmas tree! Time waits for no one and that is why it is important to make a mindful commitment now to not let this Lenten season pass you by. It is a great time to focus on growing as an everyday steward. The temptations are always there to procrastinate or to give in to spiritual laziness, but the Church's observation of Lent offers us so many tools to help us get on track. Increased devotions such as Stations of the Cross, various parish missions, or Lenten-focused literature are all gifts that your parish may be offering to assist you in this season.*

With the Passion being the focus of Lent, it is easy to contemplate the value of true generosity. How could someone give more than Jesus? He gave until His life was spent on a cross. When contemplating how we can increase our generosity in all aspects of our life, we only need to look to the cross. Of course, this also brings home to us that more may be asked of us than we bargained. The temptation is to not give too much, out of fear that we might face persecution or worse.

*But we take solace in the fact that we are disciples of One who had the same temptations. He overcame those temptations. He rejected the easy way out. His love and generosity could not be contained. He gave it all so that you and I have the chance to do the same. **This Lent, look to the greatest example of stewardship that ever lived. Jesus will show us the way to observe a Lent that will soon bring forth great Easter fruit.***

Saints Felicity and Perpetua**

The novena prayer to our Patrons will be said at all daily and weekend Masses from February 26th to March 6th. The feast day is March 7th. Please join us.



Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that began on Ash Wednesday. The practice of fasting predates Christianity. The Old Testament is full of examples of righteous men and women mortifying their flesh for the purpose of making atonement or simply to grow closer to God. Jesus himself fasted for forty days and forty nights in preparation for the beginning of his public ministry, and we see his disciples following his example in the Acts of the Apostles. Fasting continues to be an important part of Christian devotional life today. Many people feel the practice of fasting enhances their prayer and helps them fulfill St. Paul's advice to "put to death the deeds of the body" (Romans 8:13) to grow in the Spirit. Most Catholics will associate fasting with the liturgical season of Lent, which begins and ends with obligatory fasting for all members of the Latin Catholic Church.

Many know of the tradition of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. Fasting & abstinence is for adults between the ages of 18 and 59. Abstinence (not eating meat) is required starting at age 14. At age 18 fasting is required as well. Exceptions are medical/poor health and those whose work necessitates 3 full meals.

Please do not bring flowers to the Church during the Season of Lent

La Corresponsabilidad Diaria

¿Puede creer que ya llegó la Cuaresma? Hace poco estaba poniendo los adornos al arbolito de Navidad. El tiempo no se espera para nada y por eso es importante hacer un compromiso consciente ahora de no dejar que la Cuaresma nos pase. Este es el tiempo de crecer como un corresponsable discípulo diario. Las tentaciones de rendirse o de participar en la pereza espiritual siempre existirán, pero la Iglesia nos provee con varias herramientas para ayudarnos a estar enfocados. Devociones diarias, el viacrucis, las misiones y la literatura enfocada en la Cuaresma son regalos que su parroquia pueda ofrecerle para esta temporada.

Es fácil contemplar el valor de la verdadera generosidad porque la Pasión es el enfoque de la Cuaresma. ¿Cómo se puede ofrecer más que lo que ofreció Jesús? Jesús dio todo hasta que su vida terrenal llegó a su fin en la cruz. Cuando contemplemos cómo podemos ser más generosos, necesitamos considerar solamente una cosa: la cruz. Sin embargo, puede ser abrumador porque quizás se nos pida más de lo que estamos dispuestos a dar. La tentación es no dar mucho, por temor de ser perjudicados.

Pero podemos consolarnos con el hecho de que somos discípulos de alguien que tuvo las mismas tentaciones. Él pudo vencer esas tentaciones. Él tomó el camino más difícil. Su amor y su generosidad no se pudieron contener. Él lo ofreció todo para que usted y yo tuviéramos la oportunidad de hacer lo mismo. Esta Cuaresma, considere al ejemplo más grande de la corresponsabilidad que ha existido. Jesús nos mostrará la forma de vivir durante la Cuaresma que pronto traerá la fruta de la Pascua.


Las cajitas de arroz de CRS (18 de Febrero al 2 de Abril)

CHÚA NHẬT I-MÙA CHAY

Mt 4:1-11

Vạn Sự Khởi Đầu Nan

Suy niệm: Cả ba Phúc Âm Nhất Lãm đều tường thuật việc Chúa Giê-su bị Satan cám dỗ trong hoang địa lúc khởi đầu rao giảng để đối chiếu với việc ông bà nguyên tổ bị cám dỗ trong vườn địa đàng thuở hoang sơ. Khác một điều, bà E-và đã thất bại, còn Chúa Giê-su thì đã chiến thắng. “Vạn sự khởi đầu nan” với thất bại của ông bà nguyên tổ. Khi Chúa Giê-su đến để thiết lập một khởi đầu mới, tình hình còn tồi tệ hơn vì “*sự chết đã lan tràn tới mọi người, bởi vì mọi người đã phạm tội*” (Rm 5,12). Thế nhưng, trong thân phận con người Chúa Giê-su đã chiến thắng “tên cám dỗ”. Đó là tấm gương để chúng ta soi mà sống trọn mùa Chay với lòng tin tưởng và với quyết tâm chiến thắng tội lỗi.

Mời Ban: Khi chúng ta ăn chay, hãm mình, cầu nguyện... thì ma quỷ cũng gia tăng cám dỗ chúng ta đi ngược lại bằng những lời hứa hẹn đường mật nhưng thực chất đều là những cái bánh vẽ không hơn không kém. Bạn hãy nhớ lại những kinh nghiệm bại trận vì nghe theo lời dụ dỗ của ma quỷ xem nó đem lại gì cho cuộc sống của bạn. Trông trông? Day dứt? Hụt hẫng? Hối hận?...

Chia sẻ: Đâu là những “chiến thuật” ma quỷ dùng để cám dỗ Chúa? Và đối với bạn, ma quỷ dùng chiến thuật nào?

Sống Lời Chúa: Hãy tâm niệm lời này khi gặp cám dỗ: “Con chó thử thách Chúa là Thiên Chúa của con!”
