

**The Holy Father's Prayer Intention for March**  
**For disarmament and peace :** *Let us pray that nations move toward effective disarmament, particularly nuclear disarmament, and that world leaders choose the path of dialogue and diplomacy instead of violence.*

**Lent is a time to grow spiritually through penitential practices-self-denial, almsgiving, and through works of kindness and compassion.**

*We fast in Lent to allow our physical hunger to remind us of our spiritual hunger and our need for God. Fasting was practiced by righteous men and women of the Old Testament and later by Christ himself. It remains an important part of our devotional life today, being associated with Lent.*

**Fasting** - One full meal (with minimum food at other two mealtimes) and no food in-between meals (for people 18-59 years of age)

**Abstinence** - Not eating meat (14 years & older)

**All Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year.** As always, anyone for whom fasting or abstinence would pose a health risk is excused.

**Please do not bring flowers to the Church during the season of Lent**

The Stations of the Cross on March 13th will be conducted by the Catholic Daughters. Please join our parish community during Lent and be a part of this traditional Lenten practice.

**Gospel Reflection :** *Recently I received a note from a teenager I met years ago. He wrote, "Dear Father Muir, you probably do not remember me, but I wanted to thank you for your inspiring and humorous homilies at the parish. They helped me appreciate the beauty of Catholicism, which I have now embraced in a personal way." That small note moved me more than he probably imagined. I had no idea my words had taken root in him. I was simply sowing seeds — week by week, Mass by Mass. Someone else — his parents, a youth minister, or God Himself — was doing the deeper work. Now this young man is joyfully reaping a harvest of faith.*

*In today's Gospel, Jesus offers living water to a Samaritan woman whose life had been full of searching and disappointment. By the end of their encounter, she becomes a bold and joyful evangelist. Then Jesus turns to his disciples and says something easily overlooked: "**One sows and another reaps**" (John 4:37). He is helping them — and us — understand how evangelization works. Often, the one who sows the seeds of faith is not the one who sees the fruit.*

*This Lent, ask yourself: Are you in a sowing phase or a reaping phase? If you are sowing — raising children, praying for someone, mentoring — be patient. Your work matters. If you are reaping — seeing someone come alive in faith — be grateful. You are standing on sacred ground, tilled and watered by others.*

**Lenten challenge:** *Thank someone who once sowed faith into your life. And keep sowing, even when the harvest is unseen.*

## III Domingo de Cuaresma - Juan 4:5-42

Durante la Cuaresma se tiene la oportunidad de un encuentro más profundo con Dios por medio de los Sacramentos, especialmente el de la Reconciliación. Las parroquias ofrecen diferentes servicios de reconciliación y en diversos horarios, para que toda persona pueda acercarse y reconciliarse. Hoy, en este tercer domingo de Cuaresma, se nos presenta la sed como fuente de vida. El diálogo entre Jesús y la samaritana nos lo demuestra: “*Si conocieras el don de Dios, si supieras quién es el que te pide de beber, tú misma le pedirías agua viva y él te la daría*” (Juan 4:10). El comportamiento de Jesús al pedir agua a una mujer no era bien visto y contradecía las costumbres de su tiempo. Sin embargo, ese diálogo entre ambos no tiene nada de desperdicio: fue un diálogo perfecto, al grado que la mujer samaritana se convierte en misionera.

Este personaje, la mujer samaritana, no tiene nombre. De tal manera que yo puedo poner el mío y entablar mi propia conversación con el Señor en la oración. ¿A qué pozo voy por agua? ¿Dónde está Jesús, cansado y sediento? ¿Qué me pide que haga? ¿Dónde debo anunciarlo? Señor, como a la samaritana, hazme testigo de tu Evangelio. Para lograrlo, recordemos que el Espíritu Santo, desde nuestro Bautismo, ha sido derramado en nosotros como fuente de agua viva. No hay excusa para no participar como discípulos misioneros en nuestras parroquias, en la familia y en la sociedad. ¡Señor, dame de esa agua, y así ya no sufriré más sed!

## CHÚA NHẬT III-MÙA CHAY

**Ga 4:5-42**

### LOAN BÁO TIN MỪNG

**Suy niệm:** Người phụ nữ Sa-ma-ri-a chưa nhận ra “người đang nói với chị” là ai. Chị ta chỉ biết rằng đây là một người đàn ông xứ Ga-li-lê; mà người xứ Ga-li-lê thì chị biết rồi, họ coi những người Sa-ma-ri như chị bằng nửa con mắt. Chị đã hạ hê lòng “tự tôn dân tộc” bằng những câu trả lời đốp chát khi “ông Ga-li-lê” nọ xin chị nước uống. Chị cứng cỏi là thế, nhưng rồi Chúa Giê-su cũng đã giúp chị cởi mở cõi lòng để đón nhận ơn Thiên Chúa. Trước tiên, bằng thái độ hiền lành khiêm nhường, Ngài ngỏ lời cầu xin sự giúp đỡ của chị: “Cho tôi xin chút nước uống.” Ngài luôn nhẫn nại và tôn trọng chị dù Ngài biết rõ vết thương ẩn kín trong tâm hồn chị: “Chị đã nói đúng. Chị đã có năm đời chồng rồi, và người hiện đang sống với chị không phải là chồng chị.” Cuối cùng chị nhận ra “người đang nói với chị đây” không chỉ là một vị ngôn sứ mà còn là “Đấng Mê-si-a, gọi là Đức Ki-tô.”

**Mời Ban:** Đến với Chúa với tấm lòng sám hối như chị xứ Sa-ma-ri-a và từ đó đến với tha nhân với trái tim hiền lành khiêm nhường và thái độ bao dung nhẫn nại của Chúa Giê-su, để nhờ đó, giống như chị, chúng ta cũng có thể dẫn anh chị em đồng bào mình đến với Ngài.
