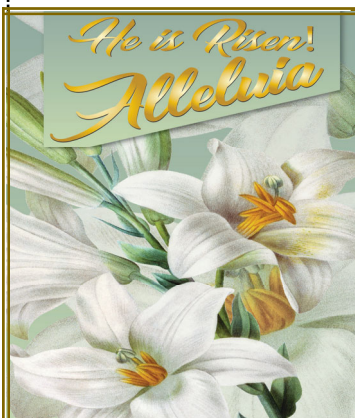

Domingo de Pascua - Juan 20:1-9

La experiencia de la Pascua de aquella mañana era, sin lugar a duda, clara y perfecta: se trataba de ver y creer. Al amanecer, muy tempranito, fue María Magdalena al sepulcro para buscar al Señor; sin embargo, ¡qué sorpresa tan grande! Estaba movida la piedra del sepulcro. De inmediato regresó para avisar a Pedro y a Juan, y les dijo: “Se han llevado del sepulcro al Señor, y no sabemos dónde lo han puesto” (Juan 20:2). ¡Qué tremenda sorpresa para ellos! Después de ver sufrir a Jesús en la cruz, ahora estaba desaparecido. Sin embargo, ese no era el plan trazado por Dios para comprender la resurrección de su Hijo. Los más cercanos a Jesús —los que habían caminado juntos, predicando, curando a los enfermos y haciendo milagros— ahora tenían que testificar que Jesús había resucitado, que estaba vivo y que era el mismo que había compartido el pan con ellos.

El Evangelio nos dice: “No habían entendido todavía la Escritura: él debía resucitar de entre los muertos” (Juan 20:9). ¡Cristo vive! En verdad ha resucitado: este es el grito de sus discípulos y de la creación entera, entonces y ahora. El gozo y la alegría deben brotar del corazón de cada cristiano. Alegrémonos con este gran regalo de la Pascua; seamos portadores de paz y no de miedo. Seamos heraldos de esperanza en medio de la hostilidad y el odio que tantas veces paralizan la gracia de Dios en el mundo. ©LPI

CHÚA NHẬT PHỤC SINH

Ga 20:1-9

NIỀM VUI PHỤC SINH: “ BÌNH AN CHO ANH EM ”

Suy niệm: Lời đầu tiên của Đức Ki-tô phục sinh nói với các môn đệ là lời chúc: “Bình an cho anh em.” Nếu chúng ta nhớ Đấng nói lời này cũng chính là Đấng trước khi chịu chết đã yêu thương các môn đệ và yêu tới cùng (x. Ga 13,1), thì chúng ta hiểu ra rằng tình yêu dẫn đến chấp nhận khổ giá thì phục sinh chính là tình yêu đem lại bình an cho người mình yêu. Tình yêu thúc đẩy bà Ma-ri-a Mác-đa-la ra mộ Chúa từ sáng sớm để than khóc; gặp được Đức Ki-tô phục sinh, than khóc đó đã trở thành niềm vui và bà được sai đi làm sứ giả đầu tiên loan báo Tin Mừng bình an rằng Chúa đã sống lại thật rồi.

Mời Ban: Cố ĐTC Phan-xi-cô đã nói: “Có những Kitô hữu sống đời mình giống như chỉ có mùa Chay mà không có mùa Phục Sinh” (Niềm vui Tin Mừng, số 6). Quả vậy, Chúa Ki-tô chịu đóng đinh sẽ chỉ là sự thất bại đáng nguyên rủa nếu như kết thúc tại Núi Sọ. Nhưng Ngài đã trỗi dậy và biến đau thương thập giá thành niềm vui phục sinh. Bạn có cảm nhận niềm vui phục sinh ấy thấm vào từng sợi thịt mạch máu của bạn, và biến bạn thành sứ giả loan báo tin mừng bình an không? Hay ngược lại, bạn vẫn sống trong lo lắng, sợ hãi, và buồn sầu như Đức Ki-tô chưa từng sống lại?

Sống Lời Chúa: Hãy chia sẻ cho một người bạn thân ngoài Công giáo về niềm vui và sự xác tín của bạn vào mầu nhiệm Chúa Ki-tô Phục sinh.

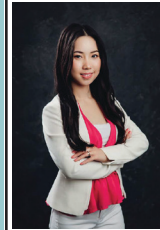

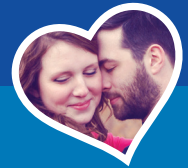
