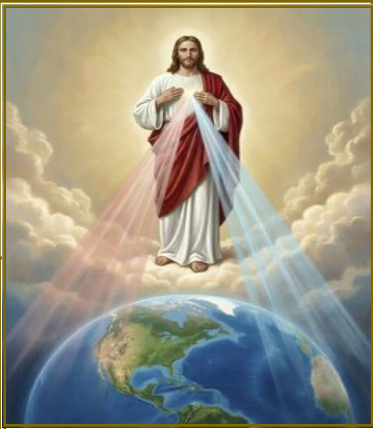

## April 12th 2026 - 2nd Sunday of Easter (Sunday of Divine Mercy)

*Sunday's Readings: Acts 2:42-47; Ps 118:2-4, 13-15, 22-24; 1 Peter 1:3-9;  
John 20:19-31*

### SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY

Saint John Paul II named the Second Sunday of Easter "Sunday of Divine Mercy" in response to Saint Faustina Kowalska's Divine Mercy devotion, which offered spiritual comfort to hearts worldwide. But Pope Francis challenged us to make the comfort that we receive a gift we gladly share, saying that because mercy was first shown to us we are therefore called to show mercy ourselves. The clearest expression of merciful love, says Francis, is pardoning others. He acknowledges how difficult it can be to forgive sometimes, but if we are to achieve peace in our hearts, pardon is the tool that has been put into our very fallible hands. The necessary condition for living joyfully? We must let go of anger, hatred, revenge, and violence. A tall order in a world seemingly bent on the destruction of every peaceful impulse.

May Divine Mercy Sunday remind us that Jesus made mercy our life's ideal and a criterion for our faith's credibility: "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy" (Matthew 5:7).

**Please join us this Sunday, April 12th as we celebrate the Divine Mercy with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 2:00 pm to 3:00 p.m. We will also have confession. At 3:00 p.m. we will say the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Please join us!**

#### Prayer of Divine Mercy

O Blood and Water that redeems and saves, have mercy on us!  
O Blood and Water that heals and restores, have mercy on us!  
O Blood and Water that strengthens and renews, have mercy on us!  
Amen.

**Gospel Reflection** : Due to the constant unchecked flow of data and information through the Internet, it can be hard to know when a story is real news or rubbish. It never ceases to amaze me when someone I know has bought into some crazy fake news story. Sometimes the story is just so unbelievable: celebrities who gained two hundred pounds in a month, women having babies who were never pregnant, or people actually being seen who are dead! Like Elvis!

The apostle Thomas found the news that Jesus was alive just too far-fetched to believe. But he didn't first hear the news on the Internet or read it standing in the grocery store checkout line. His friends told him. His fellow apostles told him they had actually seen the Lord with their own eyes. Their testimony was not enough. He needed proof.

The resurrection of Jesus gives us not only hope, but also a reason to be his disciples. We have not seen with our own eyes but, like Thomas, we have a community, the Church, that has relayed the truth to us. This same Jesus now calls us to go forth to spread the Gospel. More unbelievable than that, we have, through the gifts we have been given, a chance to change and even save lives. The day may come that you, moved by this news of the risen Lord, will be an agent of his love to the point where someone will tell the tale that you, a follower of Jesus, actually helped to change his or her life. Pretty unbelievable, right?

## CHÚA NHẬT II – MÙA PHỤC SINH

**Ga 20:19-31**

### HỌP MỪNG CHÚA SỐNG LẠI

**Suy niệm:** Khi đại dịch Covid-19 bùng phát, việc "ở nhà" là biện pháp phòng tránh dịch bệnh hữu hiệu. Các y bác sĩ đưa ra lời kêu gọi: "Chúng tôi đi làm vì các bạn, các bạn hãy ở nhà vì chúng ta." Các tông đồ cũng đã từng sống kinh nghiệm của một nhóm người chịu cách ly. Sau khi Chúa Giê-su chịu chết và được an táng trong mồ, các môn đệ sợ hãi tụ tập trong nhà, đóng kín cửa. Trong khung cảnh 'nội bất xuất, ngoại bất nhập' này, Chúa Giê-su phục sinh đã hiện ra đứng giữa họ. Ngài chúc bình an cho họ. Ngài cho các ông xem các dấu đinh nơi tay và cạnh sườn để các ông thấy Chúa và có niềm vui gặp Chúa. Ngài thổi hơi trên các ông, trao ban ơn Đức Chúa Thánh Thần, và sai các ông ra đi loan báo Tin Mừng.

**Mời Bạn:** Nói tiếp truyền thống trong Hội Thánh từ thời các Tông đồ, hàng tuần các tín hữu tham dự thánh lễ Chúa nhật để họp mừng Chúa sống lại. Đây là cơ hội vàng để cộng đoàn gặp Chúa phục sinh, lắng nghe Lời Chúa, củng cố đức tin và nhận lấy sức mạnh để dẫn thân phục vụ cho Nước Chúa giữa thế gian. Thế nhưng, có khi vì dịch bệnh, nhà thờ phải đóng cửa. Lúc đó, cùng trải nghiệm cách ly như các tông đồ, bạn vẫn có thể "ở nhà" với cộng đoàn, gia đình mình gặp gỡ Chúa qua lời cầu nguyện, suy niệm Lời Chúa để được Ngài sai đi.

**Sống Lời Chúa:** Suy niệm Tin Mừng ngày Chúa Nhật và dành ít phút hồi tâm và kết hợp với Chúa bằng việc rước lễ thiêng liêng.

**Cầu nguyện:** *Lạy Chúa Giê-su. Chúa muốn ở cùng chúng con mọi ngày cho đến tận thế. Chúng con cũng muốn dành thì giờ mỗi ngày để gặp Chúa và tâm sự với Chúa. Amen.*

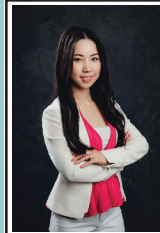

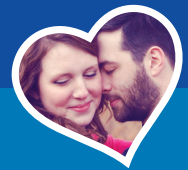
