April 19th 2026 - 3rd Sunday of Easter
Sunday's Readings: Acts 2:14, 22-33; Ps 16:1-2 and 5, 7-8, 9-10, 11; 1 Pt 1:17-21; Luke 24:13-35

Gospel Reflection : *When I first read Homer's Odyssey as a teenager, one scene captured my imagination: Odysseus finally returning home after 20 years, yet no one recognized him. Disguised as a beggar, he speaks with his wife, his son, and even his enemies. He is fully present, yet hidden. Only at the right moment does he reveal himself, and everyone realizes he has been with them all along. I was struck by the mystery that he could be so close to his loved ones, and yet they simply could not identify him.*

A similar mystery is at the heart of today's Gospel. Two disciples walk the road to Emmaus with Jesus, but "their eyes were prevented from recognizing him." (Luke 24:16) He listens, teaches, and eats with them, yet they remain blind until he breaks the bread. Suddenly their eyes are opened — and at that very moment, he vanishes. His disappearance is not absence. Rather, it is revelation. The Risen Lord is now present in a new way, in the breaking of the bread and in the life of His Church.

Faith is this shift of vision. Instead of searching for a visible Jesus as if he were absent, we learn to recognize him unveiled in hidden ways — in Scripture proclaimed, in the Eucharist, in the sacraments, in the very life of the Church.

And what is true of Him is true of us. Just as he disappears into the mission of his Body, we too are meant to be hidden in Him. When we live hidden in Christ, we are seen for who we really are.

CHÚA NHẬT III – MÙA PHỤC SINH

Lc 24:13-35

GIẢI ĐÁP CỦA ĐANG PHỤC SINH

Suy niệm: Đức Ki-tô Phục Sinh xuất hiện trên đường như một lữ khách. Người đã giải thích cuộc đời mình dưới ánh sáng Kinh Thánh. Việc duyệt lại đời Ngài giúp hai môn đệ Em-mau duyệt lại đời mình. *"Lòng ta đã chẳng bùng cháy khi nghe Người giải thích Kinh thánh trên đường chiều đó sao?"* Qua cuộc đàm thoại và chuyển hội ngộ bên quán trọ chiều hôm ấy, với những cử chỉ thân quen của Chúa *"cầm lấy bánh bẻ ra"*, họ đã nhận ra người đã chết nay là Đấng hằng sống. Tháng ngày quá khứ dường như đã chết của họ nay lại hồi sinh. Chỉ khi nhận ra Chúa Phục sinh, cuộc đời mới trở thành niềm vui.

Mời Ban: Đức Ki-tô vẫn luôn hiện diện Người đồng hành với chúng ta trên khắp nẻo đường đời. Hãy đọc cho ra mặc khải Chúa trong Thánh Kinh, sẽ thấy lửa đức tin bùng sáng lên, dù có xuôi vụn lý, cũng không thấy đường đời đơn côi. Đức tin không phải là một mớ kiến thức học được trong sách vở, nhưng là cuộc gặp gỡ cá vị và trực tiếp với Đức Ki-tô. 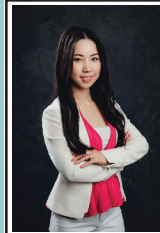

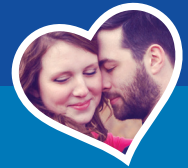
