Sunday's Readings: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a; Ps 147:12-13, 14-15, 19-20; 1 Corinthians 10:16-17; John 6:51-58

Feast of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus June 12th

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus dates back to 1673. At a monastery belonging to the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary in France, Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque began experiencing visions of the Sacred Heart that continued for 18 months. On June 16, 1675, Jesus told Sr. Margaret Mary to promote a feast that honored His Sacred Heart. In 1856, Blessed Pius IX designated the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi as the feast of the Sacred Heart for the universal Church.

This year holds a historic significance for Catholics in the United States, as the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) will officially consecrate the country to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, coinciding with the nation's 250th anniversary.

Immaculate Heart of Mary - June 13th

The Feast for the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary is held on the Saturday following the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The Immaculate Heart of Mary signifies, the great purity and love of the heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary for God. Through this devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary, we seek to have a heart more like Mary's, totally devoted and obedient to God.

Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary, we consecrate ourselves to You. O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and Immaculate Heart of Mary, accept this act of consecration, which we make out of pure love for You. Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us! Immaculate Heart of Mary, be our salvation! Jesus, meek and humble of heart, make our heart like unto Your merciful heart! Amen.

Corpus Christi - June 07, 2026

*This Sunday we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi - the Most Holy Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ - the central mystery of our liturgical life and worship. **The Eucharist is the source and summit of Christian life and it is through the Eucharist that we encounter Jesus.** To celebrate this Solemnity, we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament around the Church after the 10:30 am mass, followed by Benediction.*

Please join us for this celebration.

*Reflection : When I was a young altar server, I once overheard two very different comments about the Eucharist. One person asked, "Is Father distributing the bread or the wine?" Later, another asked, "Can you go get Jesus from the tabernacle?" Same parish, same Mass, but two very different ways of speaking. I pondered: **So, is it bread that we pretend is Jesus? Or is Jesus a tiny white thing in a box? I was utterly confused.***

*This Feast of Corpus Christi is an excellent time to think about how we should speak about the Eucharist. In today's Gospel, Jesus declares: **"My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink."** (John 6:55) His words scandalized his listeners, who feared cannibalism, and even today puzzle many, who reduce them to metaphor. Both miss the truth.*

The Church gives us better words that honor Jesus' words in the Gospel. After the consecration, we do not call it "bread" or "wine." Nor do we say, "a piece of Jesus" or even "Jesus." We say: the Eucharist. We say: the Body and Blood of Christ. We say: the Real Presence. We say: the Most Blessed Sacrament. These words safeguard the astonishing reality that Christ himself is truly present, whole and entire, under the appearances of bread and wine.

If we speak well about the Eucharist, we will think more clearly and believe more deeply. And if we believe more deeply, we will adore more truly the One who gives himself to us — not bread, not wine, but Jesus Christ himself, whole and entire.

El Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo

Juan 6:51-58

Gracias, Jesús. Nos das tu Cuerpo y tu Sangre para alimentarnos; nos lo has dado todo, no te has quedado con nada para tí, hasta la última gota de tu sangre: *“Pero al llegar a Jesús, vieron que ya estaba muerto, y no le quebraron las piernas, sino que uno de los soldados le abrió el costado con la lanza, y al instante salió sangre y agua”* (Juan 19:33-34). Nos diste al Padre, para que sea nuestro Padre; nos enviaste al Espíritu Santo, para que nos guíe en la vida; nos diste a María como Madre al pie de la cruz. Nos lo has dado todo, por eso solo me queda decir: Gracias, Señor, por todo tu amor por nosotros.

¿Cómo responder a tanto amor? ¿Qué debo hacer en particular y en comunidad? Acudamos cada domingo con un corazón agradecido, para dar gracias y alabar al Señor por la Eucaristía. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (número 1324) explica: *“La Eucaristía es fuente y cima de toda la vida cristiana. Los demás sacramentos, como también todos los ministerios eclesiales y obras de apostolado, están unidos a la Eucaristía y a ella se ordenan. La sagrada Eucaristía, en efecto, contiene todo bien espiritual de la Iglesia, es decir, Cristo mismo, nuestra Pascua.”* Es bueno que, durante la semana, meditemos en las palabras del Evangelio de este domingo. Jesús dijo: *“Yo soy el pan vivo, bajado del cielo. Si uno come de este pan, vivirá para siempre... el que come mi Carne y bebe mi Sangre, tiene vida eterna... permanece en mí y yo en él”* (Juan 6:51-56; CIC 1406). ¡Sigamos unidos a Cristo por medio de su Cuerpo y de su Sangre!

VUN ĐÁP TÌNH CHÚA BAN

Suy niệm: Lời Chúa Giê-su nói trên đây khiến nhiều người nghe chói tai lại là lời an ủi và niềm hy vọng cho các tín hữu. Bởi mỗi lần cử hành Thánh Lễ là một lần Chúa Giê-su ban chính Mình Ngài cho các tín hữu. Nhờ cử hành ấy, Hội Thánh được nối kết với cuộc Khổ Nạn hồng phúc của Chúa, được Chúa ở cùng mọi ngày cho tới ngày Chúa lại đến. 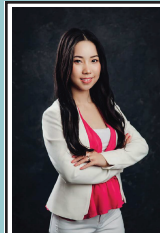

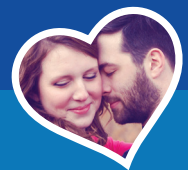
