Gospel Reflection : Jean Améry, a Holocaust survivor tortured by the Nazis, later wrote about the abyss of human evil. He described his reaction as an “indignant despair.” Haven’t we all, to some degree, felt that abyss opened beneath us? A sudden loss, a violent headline, a moment of loneliness or panic, when the world feels fragile and meaning seems to collapse?

It is to this fear that Jesus speaks in today’s Gospel: **“Do not be afraid of those who can kill the body.”** (Matthew 10:28) He does not deny evil or pretend we will never suffer. Instead, He reframes the abyss: do not fear those who can kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Your life is seen, known, and counted by the Father. Even the hairs of your head, even the sparrow’s fall.

This is no superficial comfort. Jesus himself has entered the abyss: suffering, death, even our sense of forsakenness, and he has come through it. That is why his words, “Do not be afraid,” hold such weight. They do not erase the abyss but build a bridge across it.

Faith is not pretending everything is fine. It is staring into the abyss and still choosing trust. And in that trust, we discover we are never alone. Christ stands with us, and the Father’s care surrounds us. That is the only comfort deep enough for our (often fearful) hearts.

The Nativity of St. John the Baptist June 24th

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Nativity of St John the Baptist on June 24th, and on 29th August, we will celebrate the memorial of his martyrdom. There is no other saint for whom the Church celebrates both of these moments. Generally, it celebrates only their "birth into heaven", with the exception, of course, of Jesus, the Son of God and the Virgin Mary. Jesus himself said, "Amen, I say to you, among those born of women there has been none greater than John the Baptist" (Mt. 11:11).

He was the last of the great prophets of Israel, the first to testify to Jesus, who initiated a baptism for the forgiveness of sins and, in this context, baptized Jesus; he was a martyr who died defending the Judaic law. The date of 24 June was established based on Lk 1:36a where speaking of Elizabeth it says, "this is the sixth month for her who was called barren", therefore, six months before Christmas. The June 24 feast, commonly known as **St. John's Day** is celebrated worldwide.

XII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Mateo 10:26-33

Actualmente estamos llenos de miedo: miedo a perder el trabajo, a ser deportados, o a que nuestros hijos e hijas se queden solos en este país. Son muchos los miedos que nos aterrorizan y nos paralizan de varias formas. Contra el miedo existe la confianza en que saldremos adelante de las dificultades. Pero, ¿cómo? ¿Qué hacer, cómo actuar? La única forma es prepararnos con un plan, para que no nos tome desprevenidos si llegara a suceder alguna circunstancia difícil en nuestra vida. La Palabra de Dios en la liturgia de hoy nos dice que Jesús sigue preparando a sus discípulos para afrontar las adversidades: *“Pero no les tengan miedo. Nada hay oculto que no llegue a ser descubierto, ni nada secreto que no llegue a saberse”* (Mateo 10:26).

El miedo lo experimentamos todos, viejos y jóvenes. Por eso, Jesús prepara a sus discípulos para que estén listos, y nos prepara a nosotros para lo mismo. Decía el Papa Francisco que el miedo es uno de los peores enemigos de la vida cristiana. Todo lo que genera inseguridad en la vida es lo desconocido: lo que no vemos ni sentimos, lo que no podemos controlar. Pongámonos del lado de Dios y tengamos confianza. En nuestra oración digamos, como sus apóstoles: *“Señor, auméntanos la fe”* (Lucas 17:5). Confiar en Dios es un proceso de toda la vida, pero Él no defrauda y calma toda tempestad, por muy dura que sea. ¡Gracias Señor, por estar siempre conmigo!

CHÚA NHẬT XII – MÙA THƯỜNG NIÊN

Mt 10:26-33

ĐỪNG SỢ

Suy niệm: Sống trong cuộc đời này, con người luôn có nhiều nỗi sợ: sợ đói khát, sợ bị khinh thường, sợ đau khổ... và nhất là sợ chết. Sợ hãi là cảm xúc tự nhiên, giúp con người nhận diện những nguy hiểm, đồng thời thúc đẩy ta hành động để bảo vệ mạng sống. Thế nhưng, trên đường vươn tới sự trưởng thành, hoàn thiện, có những nỗi sợ ta phải vượt qua, có những điều ta phải biết kính sợ. Vì thế, Chúa Giê-su mời gọi ta “hãy sợ Đấng có thể tiêu diệt cả xác lẫn hồn trong hỏa ngục.” Duy chỉ có Thiên Chúa là Đấng mà con người phải kính sợ, bởi Ngài là Đấng làm chủ sự sống: có thể tiêu diệt cả xác lẫn hồn trong hỏa ngục cũng như trao ban cho con người sự sống đời đời. Và Thiên Chúa ấy cũng là Đấng giàu lòng thương xót, vẫn hằng quan tâm chăm sóc những ai tin tưởng, phó thác mọi sự cho Ngài.

Mời Ban: Chúa Giê-su đã từng lo buồn đổ mồ hôi máu, trải qua nỗi sợ khi đối diện với thập giá. Nhưng với lòng tin tưởng, phó thác vào Chúa Cha, Ngài đã vượt qua sự chết, đem lại sự sống đời đời cho muôn người. Theo gương Chúa Giê-su, bạn hãy trút mọi lo âu, muộn phiền đời mình trong vòng tay yêu thương của Thiên Chúa vì Người chăm sóc chúng ta (x. 1Pr 5,7).

Sống Lời Chúa: Mỗi khi gặp những khó khăn khiến bạn chùn bước, hãy phó thác cho Chúa với lời nguyện: “*Lạy Chúa, xin đồng hành cùng con, vì Chúa làm tốt hơn con gấp ngàn lần.*”

Cầu nguyện: *Lạy Chúa, xin ban thêm cho con lòng cậy tin vững vàng, để con không nao núng, sợ hãi trước những gì chỉ gây hại cho thân xác. Xin cho con trung kiên sống đẹp lòng Chúa hơn.*

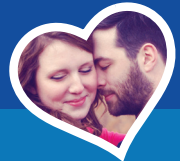
