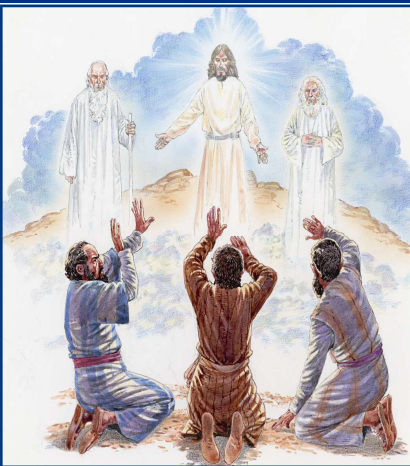

The Transfiguration of the Lord - Aug. 6th

The Feast of the Transfiguration commemorates the dedication of the basilicas on Mount Tabor. It originated as early as the end of the 5th century, after the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 14) came to be celebrated. 6 August, the date set for the Feast, is 40 days prior to the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross, manifesting its close connection with it.

In verse 17:9 which concludes the Transfiguration narrative, Matthew calls it a "vision." **Scripture scholars call it an apocalyptic vision.** An apocalyptic vision gives the suffering visionaries a glimpse into their future glory. The Transfiguration is best understood as an apocalyptic vision. At the Transfiguration the disciples, just like Daniel, are given a vision of who Jesus really is ("This is my beloved Son"), and what he will be in God's kingdom in the future. It was important that the disciples have an insight into Jesus' identity and his future destiny because soon, Jesus would be persecuted. He would go down the mountain and embrace human life in its totality – suffering, questions, challenges, crises, and all. He does not run away from life. Rather, he embraces it in obedience to God's will and for human redemption. When this happens the disciples must remember who Jesus is and the future glory that awaits Him. They must remember Moses, and Elijah and the voice that said, "This is my beloved Son." After the resurrection, the disciples did the same.

For us too, life is a complex and complicated reality. Sometimes life offers us choices and sometimes it does not. As we face life, like Jesus, we know that we are God's beloved sons and daughters and that we too must embrace life like Jesus did – suffering, questions, challenges, crises, and all. We do not run away from life but embrace it in all its complexity.

Gospel Reflection : In his song, "Lose Yourself," the artist Eminem raps, **"the mood all changed."**

We all know that moment when the mood changes, when life turns from lighthearted to deadly serious. That happens in today's Gospel. Jesus has just heard that John the Baptist, his cousin, forerunner, and friend, has been murdered. As Matthew tells us, **"When Jesus heard of it, he withdrew in a boat to a deserted place by himself."** Until now, he had been teaching in parables and healing quietly. But John's death signals a new phase. The shadow of the Cross begins to fall. Evil shows its teeth.

And how does Jesus respond? Not with rage or despair. He goes to a lonely place to go into deep communion with his Father. From that silence comes action. He feeds the multitude. Out of grief comes generosity. Out of sorrow, life.

This is the rhythm of every disciple's life. When tragedy or violence breaks our hearts, we face a choice. We can react, or we can retreat into prayer — like and with Christ. This is the hidden place where pain becomes compassion and compassion becomes self-gift.

Lord Jesus, when life intensifies, draw me into Your quiet strength. In that hidden place with You and the Father, turn my heartbreak into the bread of love for the world. Amen.

XVIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario - Mateo 14:13-21

Cuando Jesús se entera de la muerte de Juan el Bautista, decide embarcarse él solo y retirarse a lejos. Sintió un profundo dolor por aquella muerte injusta. Sin embargo, el Evangelio nos narra que la gente salió de los pueblos y se fueron a pie por la orilla para esperarlo cuando Él llegara. El texto nos sigue narrando que Jesús sintió misericordia por todas aquellas personas y las acogió, curó y atendió, porque Él no quiere que nadie pase necesidad. Al llegar la tarde, sus discípulos querían que despidiera a la gente para que fueran a buscar alimento. A esto Jesús responde: *“No tienen por qué irse; denles ustedes de comer”* (Mateo 14:16). A raíz de esta pregunta surge el milagro de la multiplicación de los panes.

“Vivir la comunión con Cristo es algo muy distinto de permanecer pasivos y ajenos a la vida cotidiana; por el contrario, nos introduce cada vez más en la relación con los hombres y mujeres de nuestro tiempo, para ofrecerles un signo concreto de la misericordia y de la atención de Cristo. Mientras nos nutre de Cristo, la Eucaristía que celebramos nos transforma poco a poco también a nosotros en Cuerpo de Cristo y en alimento espiritual para los hermanos. Jesús quiere llegar a todos, para llevar a todos el amor de Dios” (Papa Francisco, 17-08-2016). ¿Qué nos dice Jesús hoy, a ti y a mí? ¿Qué debemos hacer para atender las necesidades de los demás? El reto es confiar en la Palabra de Dios y poner nuestros propios panes y peces al servicio de quien lo necesite.

CỘNG TÁC VỚI CHÚA

Suy niệm: Chúa Giê-su trông thấy một đoàn người đông đảo thì chạnh lòng thương và chữa lành các bệnh nhân của họ. Ngài không chỉ chữa lành mà còn cho họ ăn. Chỉ với “vỏ vụn năm chiếc bánh và hai con cá,” phần đóng góp ít ỏi từ các môn đệ, Chúa Giê-su đã làm nên một phép lạ vĩ đại cho đoàn người chùng “năm ngàn đàn ông, không kể đàn bà và trẻ con” được ăn no nê. Thật vậy, sự cộng tác của con người ngay cả khi xét theo giá trị vật chất cũng rất là nhỏ bé, nhưng khi kết hợp với Chúa, nó trở nên hành động cứu độ.

Mời Ban: Thế giới hôm nay đang đối diện với bao biến động về kinh tế vì bệnh dịch lan tràn khắp nơi, thiên tai, biểu tình, nguy cơ dẫn đến chiến tranh. Chúa chạnh lòng thương xót nhân loại đang đau khổ, Chúa có thể làm mọi sự để cứu con người nhưng Chúa cần đến sự cộng tác nhỏ bé của chúng ta. Chúa muốn chúng ta cũng chạnh lòng thương trước những người đang cần chúng ta giúp đỡ. Dù sự đóng góp của chúng ta chẳng thấm vào đâu so với nhu cầu của thế giới nhưng Chúa sẽ đón nhận và nhân lên gấp bội, để đem lại lợi ích cho nhiều người.

Chia sẻ: Bạn có quảng đại dâng hiến đời mình cho Chúa hay giúp đỡ và chia sẻ với tha nhân về vật chất, thời gian, trí tuệ, sức khỏe không?

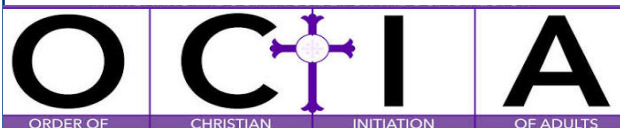
9:00 am - 11:30 am for 1st year
