Sunday's Readings: *Ezekiel 33:7-9; Ps 95:1-2, 6-7b, 7c-9; Romans 13:8-10, Matthew 18:15-20*

Gospel Reflection : *A few summers ago, my family had a big reunion. It included my parents, my four siblings, and all their many children. One of my favorite moments was simply watching my parents' contented faces as they took in all of us together, laughing, sharing food, singing, telling stories. They loved seeing their children happily together with each other.*

That is something like the heart of God we see in today's Gospel message about Christian reconciliation. These verses come right after Jesus' parable of the lost sheep. He is not giving the disciples a cold formula for dealing with conflict. He is revealing the Father's longing for children who love and reconcile with each other. His heart aches when his children are divided and isolated.

So when Jesus says, "Go and tell your brother his fault," He is not deputizing us as morality police. He is inviting us into his mission of reconciliation. When he adds, "If he listens to you, you have won over your brother," we glimpse the real goal. Not winning arguments, but reuniting a divided family.

These days, we often think religion is just between God and me. But the Father's dream is about a lively family, one in which His children forgive, gather, and rejoice together.

Lord Jesus, give me the courage to seek reconciliation where it is needed. Make my heart resemble the Father's heart, longing and working for unity among His children. Amen.

6 de septiembre de 2026 - XXIII Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Hoy la Liturgia nos anima a la corrección fraterna; es decir, nos alienta a corregir a las personas que obran mal. Este consejo parece ir contra la corriente actual de la sociedad, donde se cree que todo está permitido. Los padres tienen miedo de reprender a sus hijos y los maestros temen corregir a sus estudiantes, pues muchas veces responden con agresividad. El capítulo 18 del Evangelio de Mateo nos enseña cómo afrontar situaciones difíciles en la vida familiar y comunitaria. Siempre habrá conflictos; el reto está en cómo los afrontamos. Recordemos que somos responsables de quienes viven con nosotros y que, por derecho, deben ser felices.

Los pasos para corregir, de acuerdo con Jesús, son los siguientes: “*Si tu hermano ha pecado, ve y háblale a solas para corregirlo. Si te escucha, habrás ganado a tu hermano*”. El segundo paso es este: “*Si no te escucha, toma contigo a una o dos personas más, de modo que el caso se decida por la palabra de dos o tres testigos. Si se niega a escucharlos, informa a la asamblea*” (Mateo 18:15-16). Luego vienen las palabras alentadoras de Jesús, que ayudan a suavizar las situaciones: “*Pues donde están dos o tres reunidos en mi Nombre, allí estoy yo, en medio de ellos*” (Mateo 18:20). Se necesita saber dialogar entre las personas, escuchar incluso cuando no se está de acuerdo, y tener mucha paciencia para lograr un crecimiento integral de cada persona.

¡Señor, ayúdanos a ser responsables unos de otros y a buscar siempre la justicia y el bien común!

NHỮNG ĐIỀU KHÓ NÓI

Suy niệm: Không gì khó nói hơn việc đi sửa lỗi người khác. Vì nhiều lý do. Trước hết, lý do bản thân: tôi cũng chẳng hay ho gì mà dám lên mặt dạy đời. Và bao nhiêu lý do khác. Nếu cùng là người trong nhà với tôi: bực nhà không thiêng. Nếu không phải là người nhà với mình: thôi thì đền nhà ai nhà nấy rạng. Bao giờ người ta cũng có lý do để né tránh vấn đề gai góc này. Chắc phải ‘uống mật gấu’ mới đủ dũng khí để “sửa lỗi cho người khác” bởi chung cục tự ái của mỗi người chẳng khác nào trái bom hẹn giờ không biết lúc nào sẽ nổ tung lên. Trên đây, Chúa Giê-su đưa ra qui tắc vàng: muốn sửa lỗi cho nhau, phải được thúc đẩy bởi tình bác ái, phải tôn trọng danh dự của nhau và nhắm đến lợi ích đích thực của người anh em. Việc đi gặp riêng “một mình anh với nó thôi” tạo điều kiện cho một cuộc đối thoại ôn hòa, tôn trọng lẫn nhau và giúp nhau nhận ra thánh ý Chúa.

Mời Bạn: Bạn có nghĩ rằng 99% thất bại trong việc sửa lỗi phát sinh do việc nóng nảy, thiếu tế nhị, thiếu tôn trọng nhau? Về phần mình, khi được người khác sửa lỗi, bạn đã phản ứng thế nào?

Sống Lời Chúa: Suy niệm nhiều lần những đoạn Tin Mừng trên.

Cầu nguyện: Lạy Chúa Giê-su, xin dạy con biết noi gương Chúa, ghét tội nhưng thương người có tội, biết sẵn sàng hy sinh đền thay tội lỗi cho anh em mỗi khi con muốn sửa lỗi cho nhau.
