The Why - Reflection

Sometimes, the Gospel takes everything you think you know about Jesus, throws it in a box, shakes it violently, dumps it on the floor, looks you in the eye and says: "Clean it up." And there you are, picking up the pieces, wondering how, after 2,000 years, someone can still keep you guessing.

Today is one of those Gospels. We know Jesus as a champion of the poor. We envision him as a social justice warrior. And now he's advocating for time theft in the workplace? Make it make sense. Well, at its heart, today's Gospel is a story about who gets what. A story about comparison, which we are told is the thief of joy — but without comparison, nothing would ever get done. In this world, wages are set, court cases are settled, international borders are drawn, all by comparing one entity to another and evaluating that comparison to make a judgment.

*What this Gospel doesn't tell us is the "why." The workers who labored longest in the vineyard feel cheated because those who showed up later earn the same wage. This would be egregious — unless we consider that the only criteria used in the comparison is the length of the work day's duration. Quality and efficiency of work is never even mentioned. For all we know, those all-day workers could have been standing around fanning themselves, and should feel lucky to get what they did. "Why" is a question we ask a lot in this life. Why did my dad die? Why did I get cancer? Why did my husband lose his job? As we pick up the pieces of today's Gospel, we should ask ourselves this: **when we know what we know about Who decides who gets what, do we have to know the "why?"***

CHÚA NHẬT XXV – MÙA THUỜNG NIÊN

Mt 20:1-16

VÌ MỘT CỘNG ĐỒNG BIẾT CHIA SẺ

Suy niệm: Trong thời đại toàn cầu hoá hiện nay, các sản phẩm càng ngày càng đòi hỏi chất lượng cao với kỹ thuật tinh vi hiện đại. Vì thế, muốn có việc làm lương cao, phải có trình độ chuyên môn cao. Muốn thế thì phải học hành cao mới đáp ứng nổi yêu cầu. Thế nhưng chi phí đầu tư cho việc học hành lại vượt quá khả năng của những người nghèo cơm ăn bữa no bữa đói. Thế nên, người nghèo bị bó chặt trong cái vòng luẩn quẩn của kiếp nghèo, bị loại ra bên lề cuộc chơi ‘chất lượng cao’, giống như những người thợ vườn nho đành đứng ngoài ngáp ruồi “vì không ai mướn chúng tôi.” Lời Chúa hôm nay thúc bách chúng ta nghĩ đến một toàn cầu hoá “không-loại-trừ” thay vì một toàn cầu hoá ‘hoang dã’, một nền kinh tế chia sẻ thay vì một nền kinh tế tiêu thụ ích kỷ.

Mời Ban: Bác ái trong thời đại toàn cầu hoá đòi hỏi bạn bước ra khỏi ‘căn nhà’ tiện nghi, và an toàn của mình để tìm gặp những người đang bị gạt ra bên lề đó, không chỉ để bố thí cho họ một chút cơm thừa, mà là tìm cách tốt nhất chia sẻ với họ cả những điều kiện, những cơ hội để họ có thể thăng tiến cuộc sống.

Chia sẻ: Có nhiều trường hợp đòi hỏi sự chia sẻ ‘tổng lực’ của cả cộng đoàn. Nhóm của bạn điểm ra những trường hợp như thế và lên kế hoạch chia sẻ.
